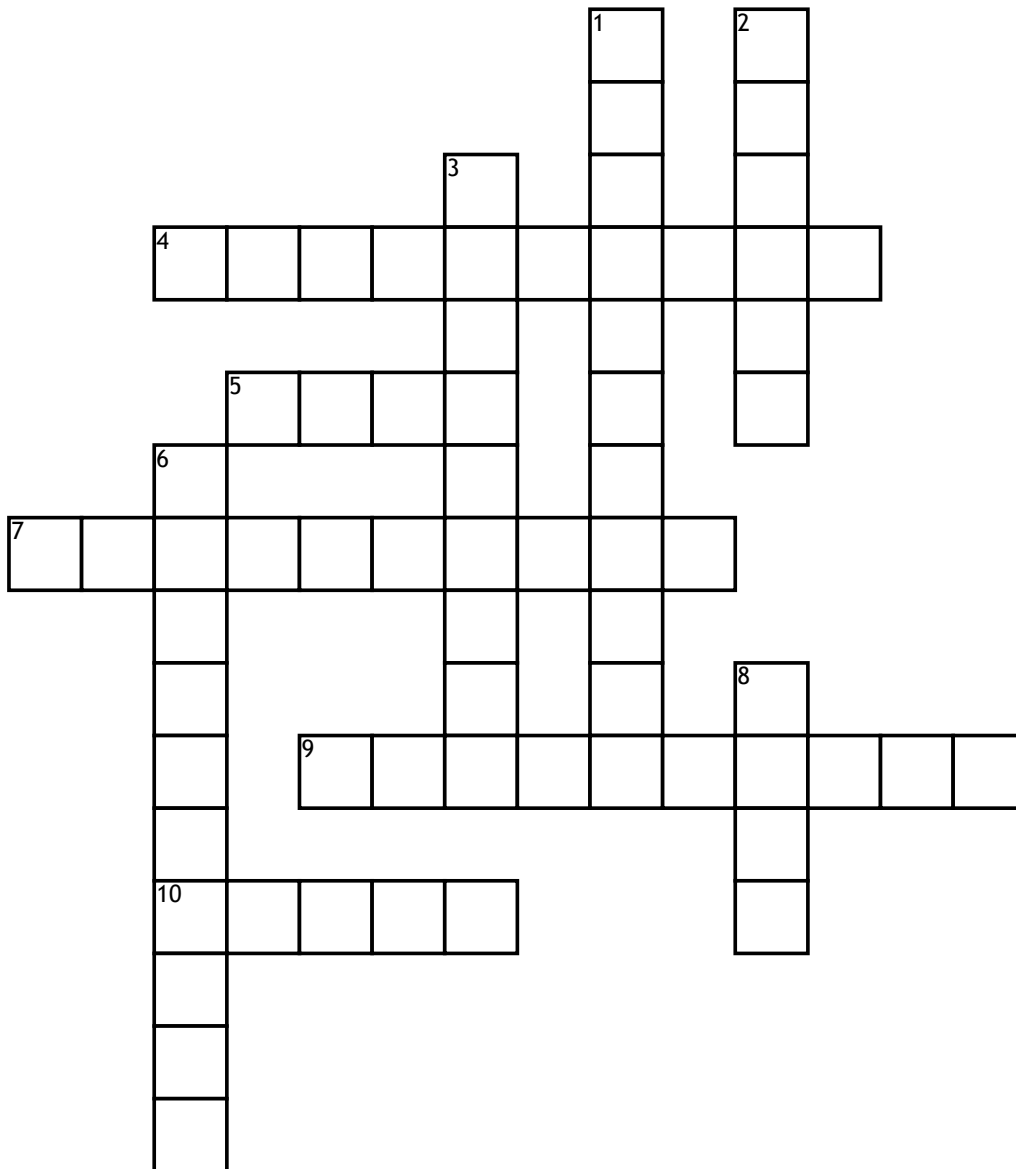


Inflammation

1. A condition of shortening and hardening of muscles, tendons, or other tissue, often leading to deformity and rigidity of joints.
2. An area of irregular fibrous tissue formed at the site of a scar or injury.
3. A mass of granulation tissue, typically produced in response to infection, inflammation, or the presence of a foreign substance.
