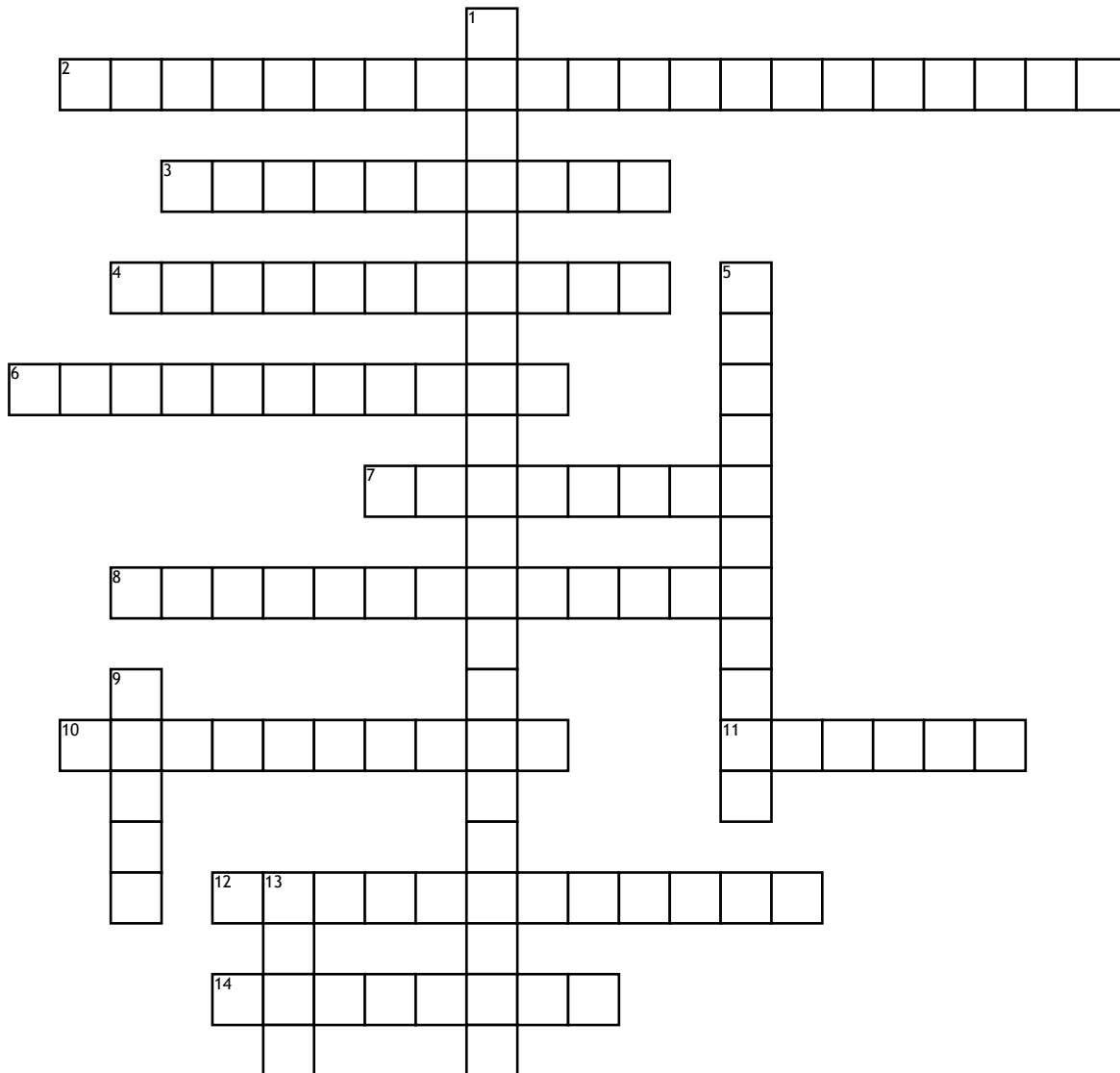


Insurance Crossword
