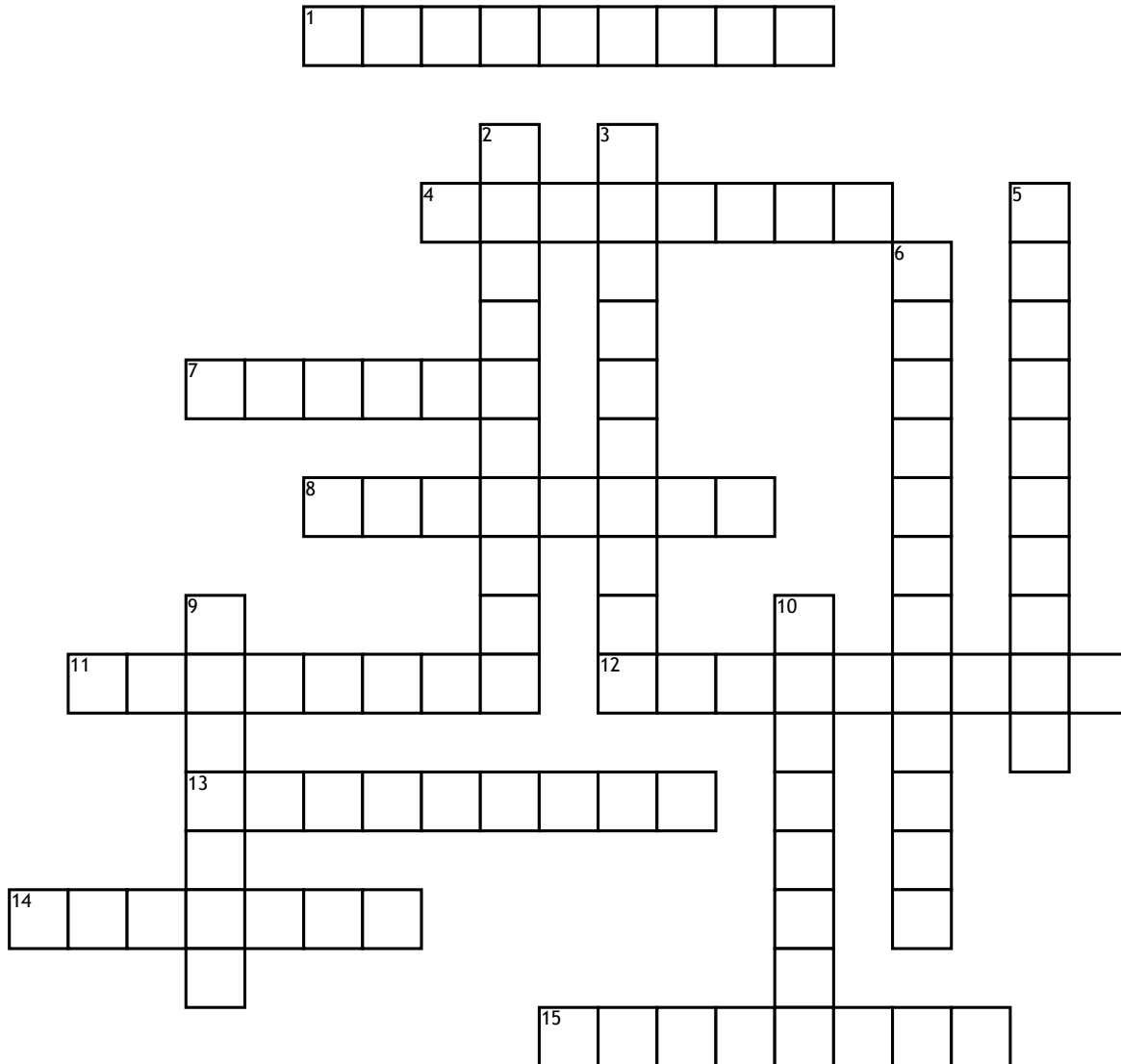


Integumentary Medical Terminology

1. Infection that causes warts in various parts of the body, depending on the strain.
4. The most serious type of skin cancer.
7. Fatty lump most often situated between the skin and underlying muscle layer.
8. Group of inherited disorders characterized by little or no melanin production.
11. Defined as the bluish or purplish discoloration of the skin or mucous membranes due to the tissues near the skin surface having low oxygen saturation.

12. Relating to oil or fat.

13. Relating to or affecting the skin.

14. Basal layer of the epidermis consisting of a single row of columnar or cuboidal epithelial cells that continually divide and replace the rest of the epidermis as it wears away.

15. Hair loss from the scalp or elsewhere on the body.

2. A general term that describes inflammation of the skin.
3. Inflammation of the blood vessels that causes changes in the blood vessel walls.

5. Acute inflammation of the gallbladder in the absence of gallstones.

6. Condition of normal body temperature.

9. A band or sheet of connective tissue, primarily collagen, beneath the skin that attaches, stabilizes, encloses, and separates muscles and other internal organs.

10. A liver condition that causes yellowing of a newborn baby's skin and eyes.
