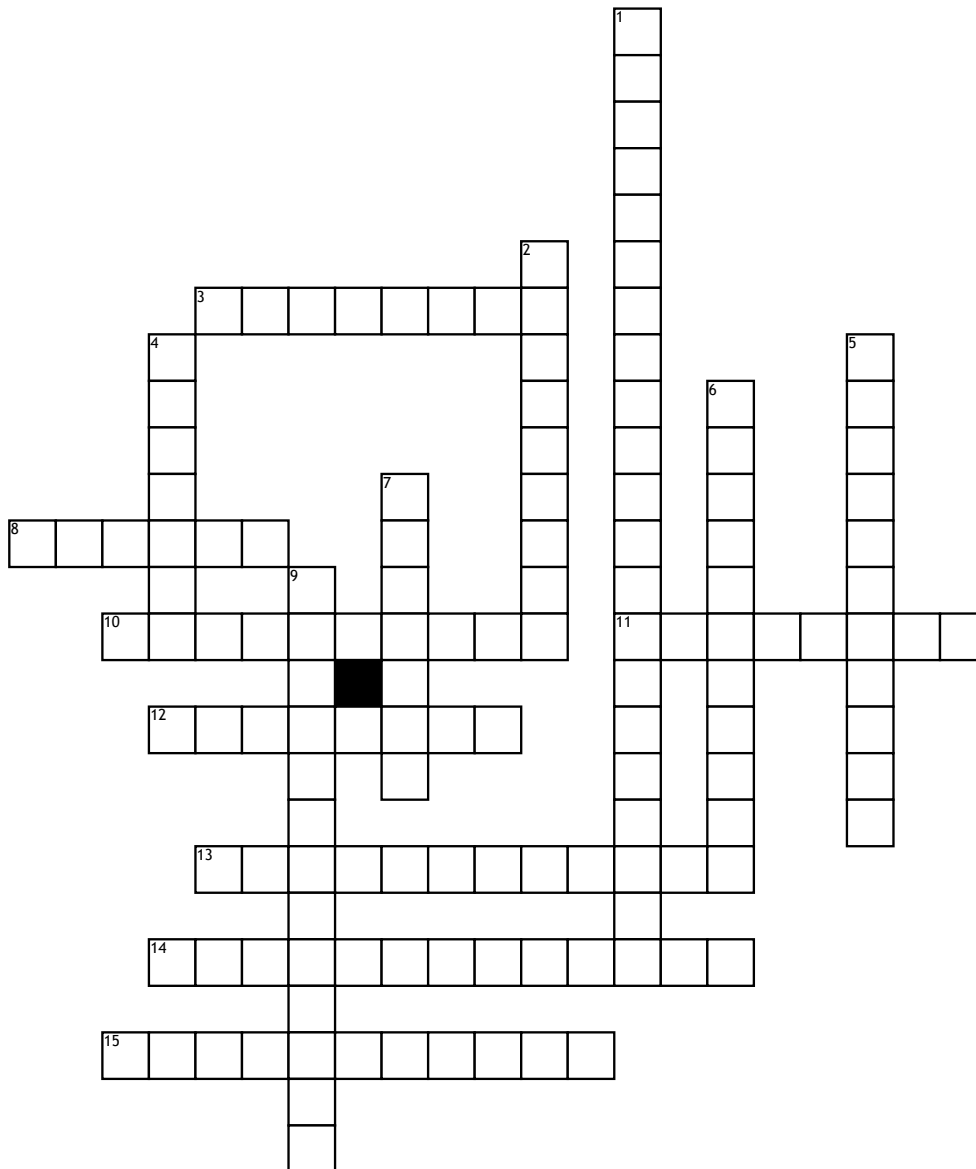


Integumentary System
