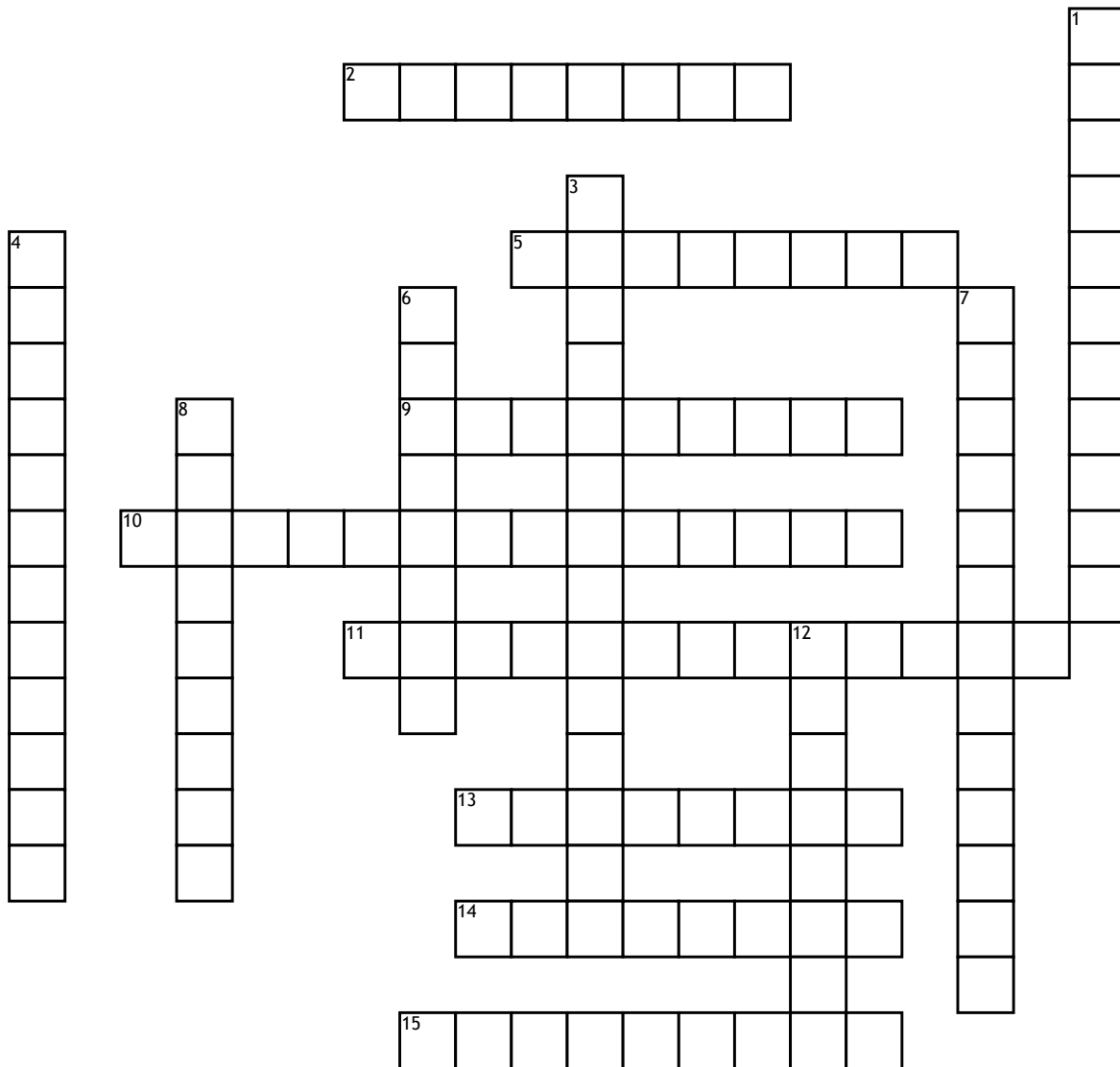


# Integumentary system

- 2. Yellow staining of the skin and sclerae by abnormally high blood levels of the bile pigment bilirubin
- 5. a cancer of the melanocyte, the cell that produces pigment in the skin.
- 9. a normal gland of the skin which empties an oily secretion into the hair follicle near the surface of the skin
- 10. outermost layer of the skin
- 11. involuntary contractions or twitchings of groups of muscle fibers

13. Hair loss from the scalp or elsewhere of the body

14. Bluish or purplish discoloration of the skin or mucous membranes due to the tissues near the skin surface

15. a small solid benign tumor with a clear cut border that projects above the surrounding tissue

1. A molecule that is a combination of a lipid and a protein

3. Common type of benign skin tumor that is small, slow growing, typically firm, red-to-brown bumps.

4. Abnormal persistent fear of heat

6. consisting of blood vessels, especially those that carry blood

7. a rounded swollen area of the skin formed by an abnormal sac of retained excretion from the sebaceous follicles
