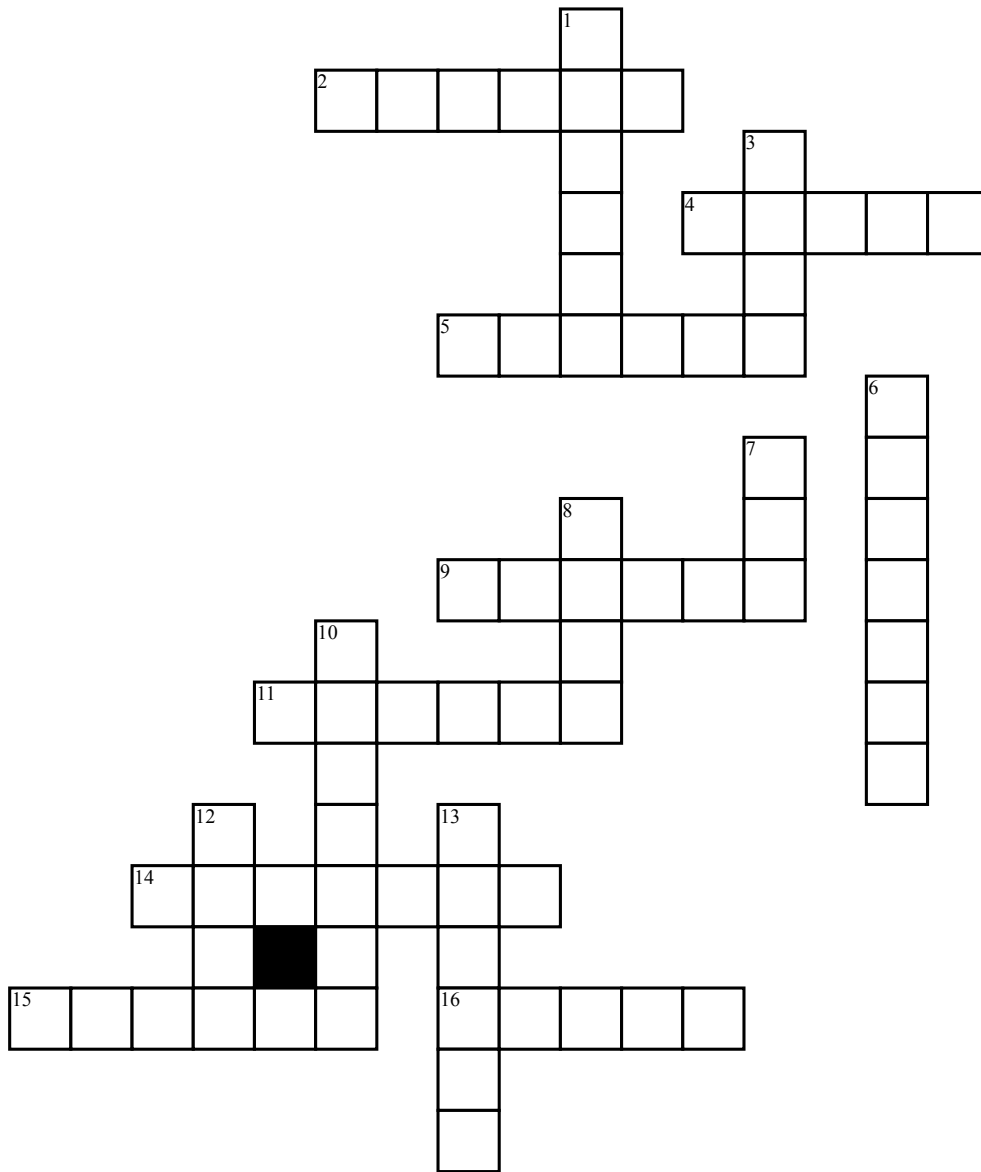


# Interrogatives Crossword Puzzle
