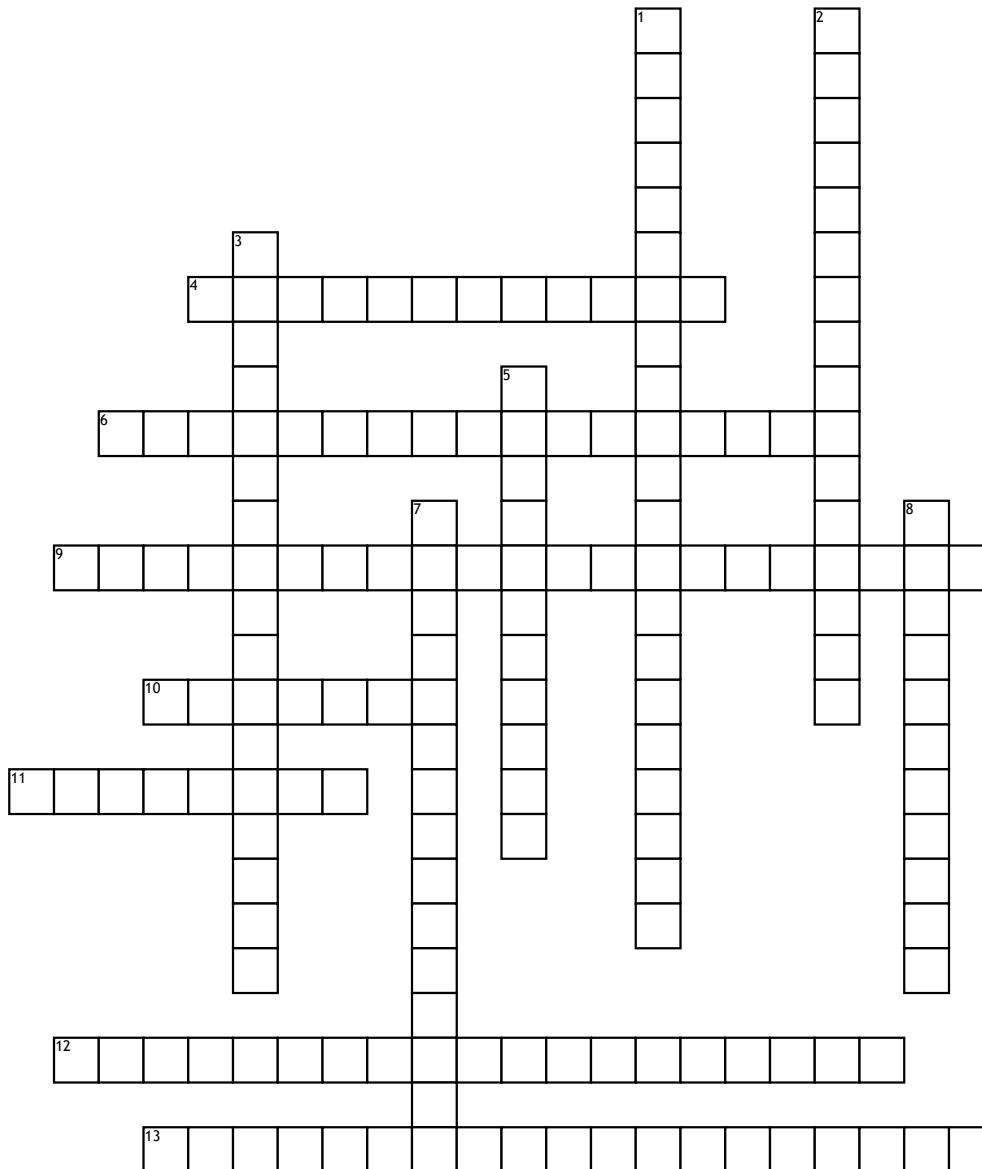


# Intro to Psych Crossword Puzzle
