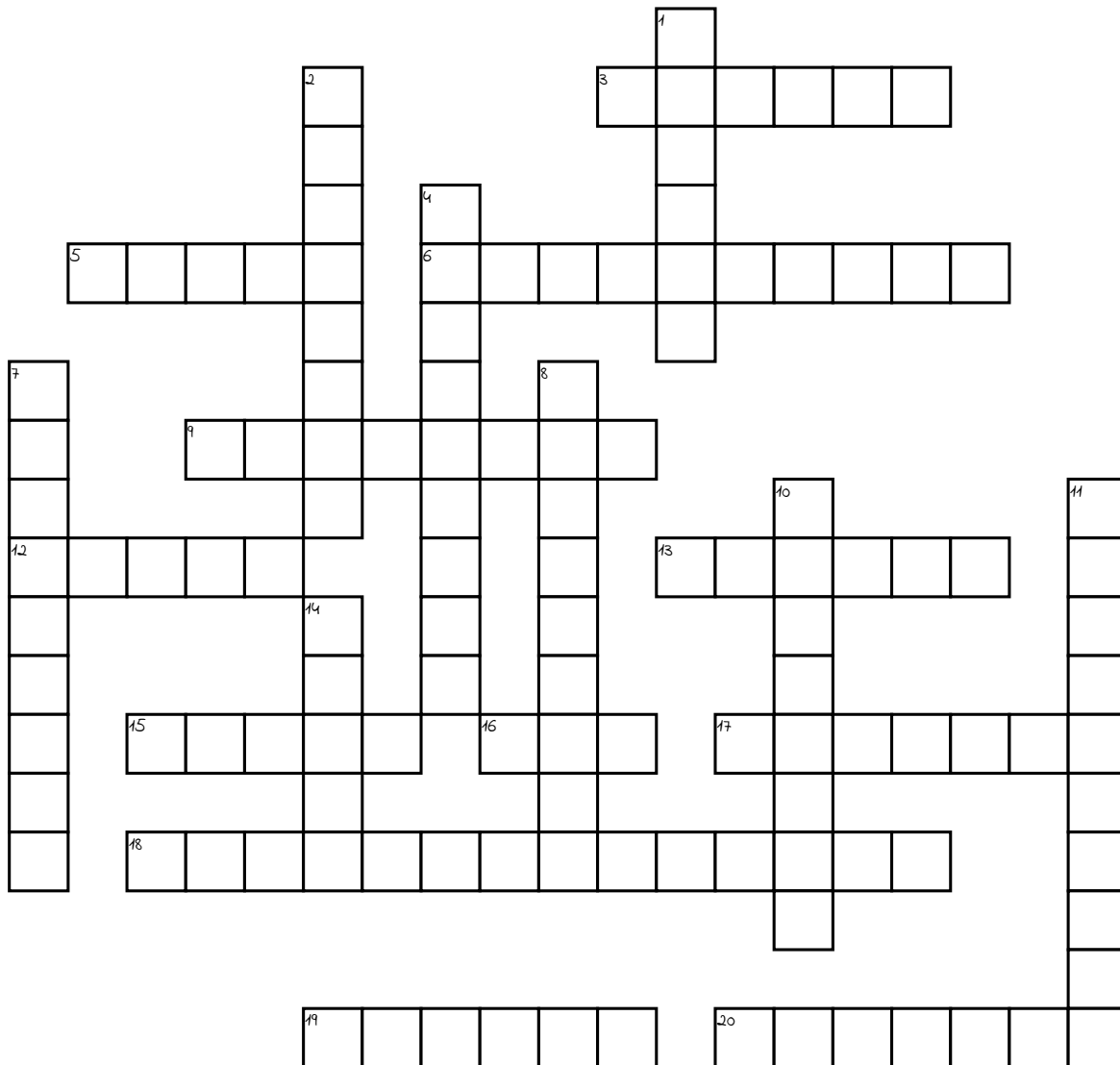


# Introductory Rite/Liturgy of the word vocabulary
