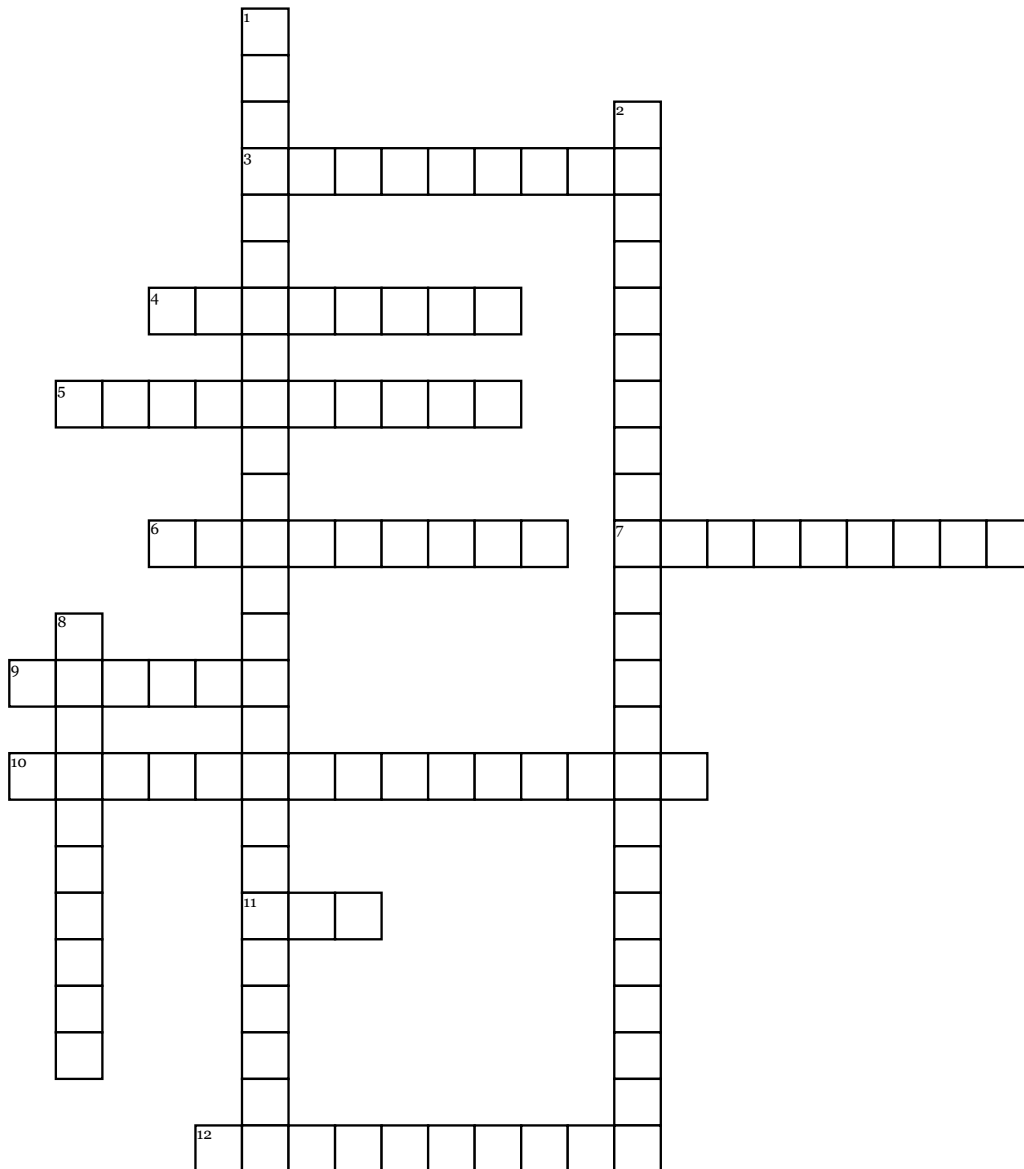


Intubation

3. Often overlooked for intubated patients in the emergency room; required for comfort post intubation

4. Required for patients post intubation; should be adequate to prevent dislodging of tube by patient.

5. Airway visualization system used in tracheal intubation

6. abbrev; diagnostic examination performed to verify placement of ETT

7. Short acting anesthetic agent used for tracheal intubations.

9. Thin, flexible instrument used for guidance; introducer

10. Neuromuscular blockade agent used for tracheal paralysis; side effect profile includes hyperkalemia.

11. Tool used for manual resuscitation for patients requiring assistance with ventilation and oxygenation; provides positive pressure ventilation

12. Procedure in which a tube is placed in the airway to assist with ventilations in patients who are acutely sick or injured.

1. Method of intubation requiring pre-oxygenation of the profoundly hypoxic patient.

2. Preferred method of intubation for patients at risk of aspiration or impending airway compromise

8. Neuromuscular blockade agent used in intubation, side effect of hepatotoxicity.
