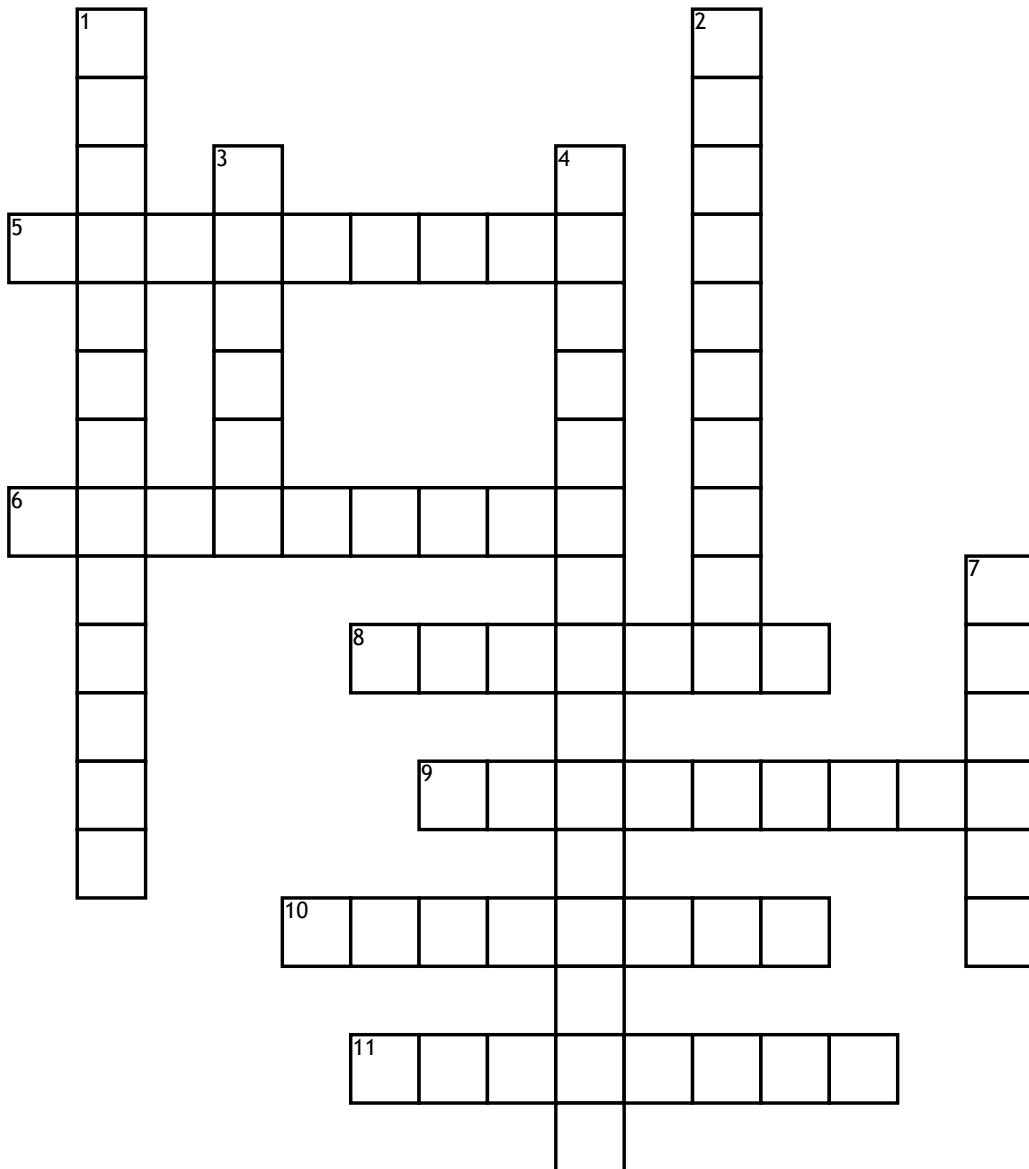


Invertebrate Classification
