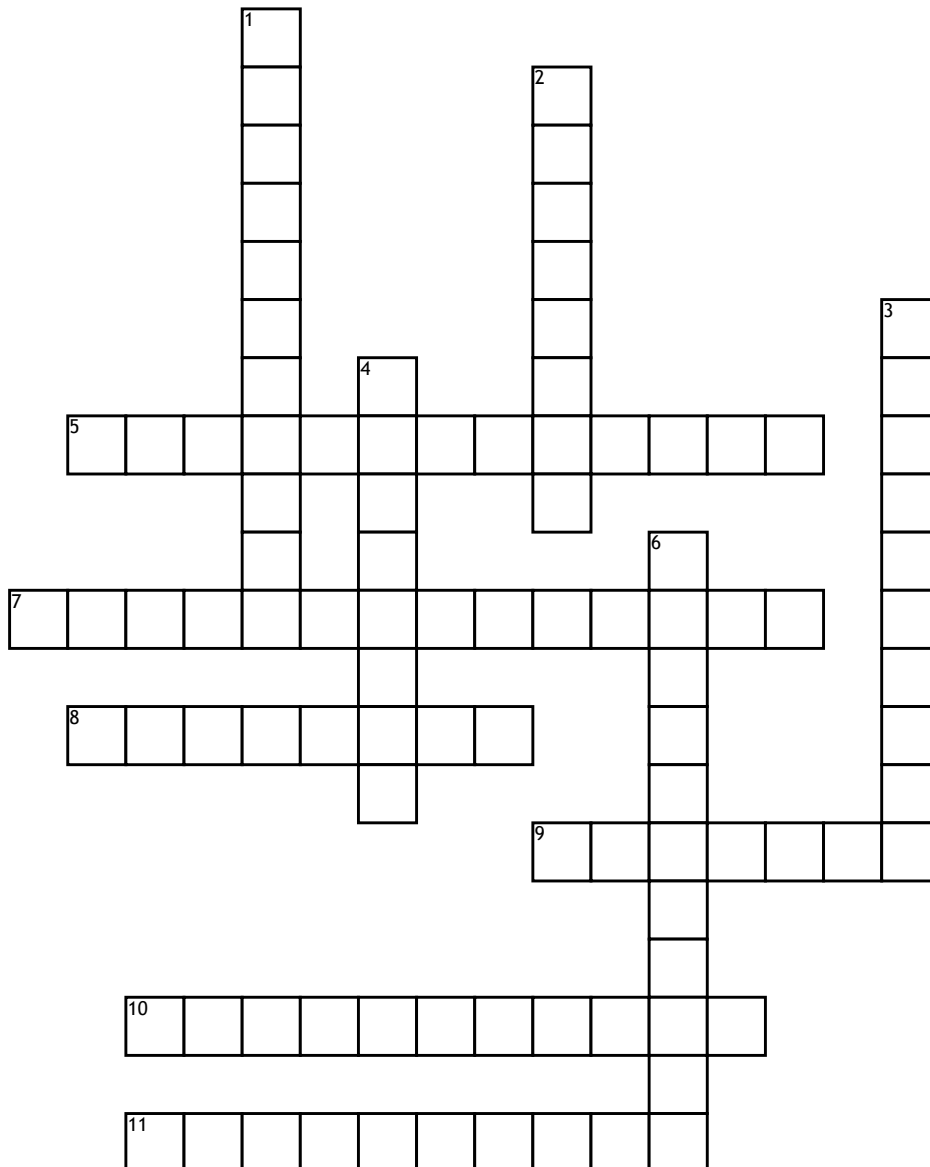

11. This invertebrate group has tentacles, a hollow soft body and no organs

1. A starfish is an example of this invertebrate group
2. The quality of being made up of exactly similar parts facing each other or around an axis
3. This invertebrate group usually has paired jointed legs, a segmented body and they make up over 85% of all animal species on Earth
4. A spiny five pointed invertebrate which has radial symmetry
