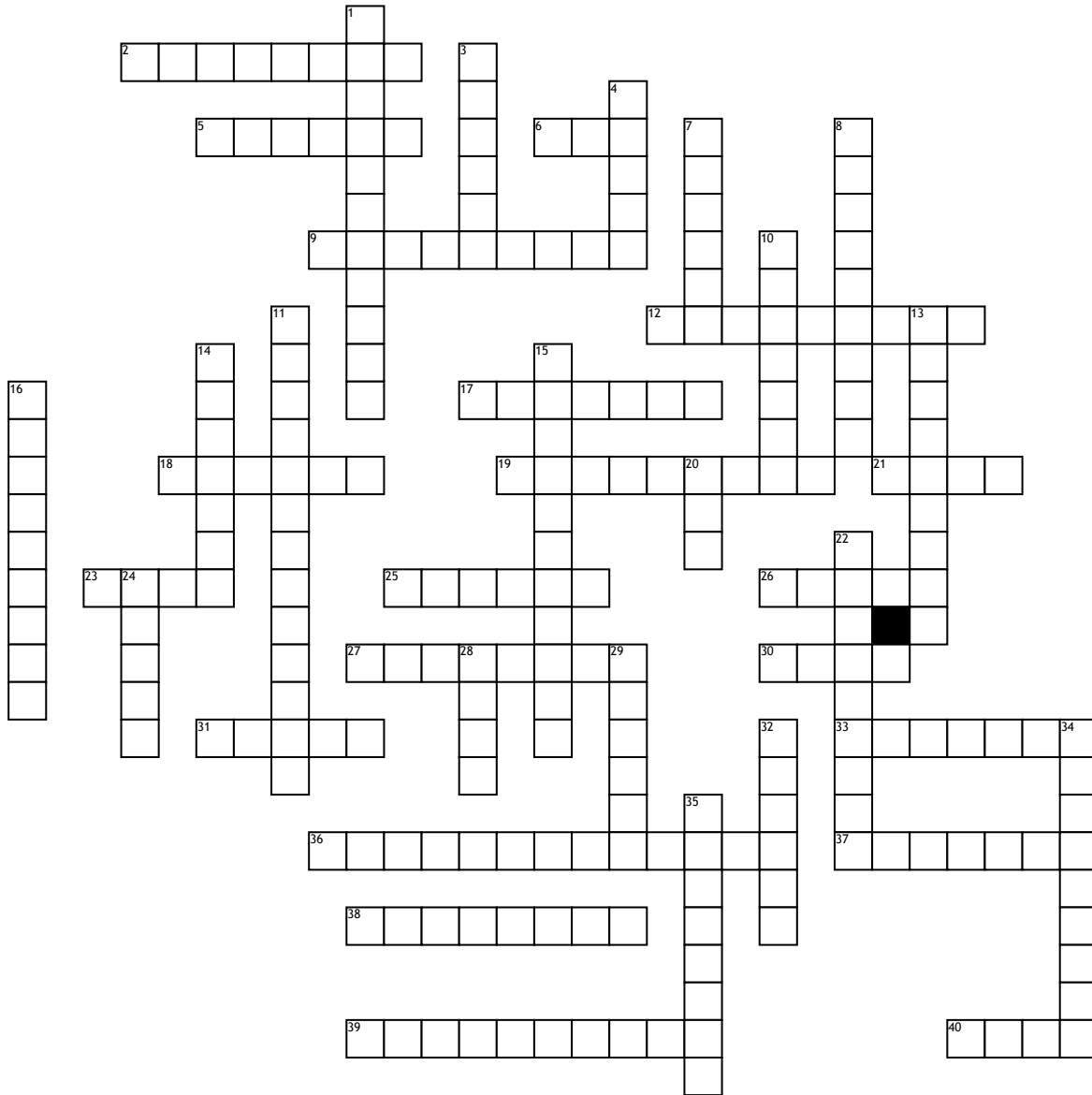

- 2. They have eight legs and are easily recognized by the pair of grasping pedipalps and the narrow
- 5. Salt water bivalve molluscs that live in marine or brackish habitats
- 6. flying insects known for their role in pollination
- 9. insects of the order Blattodea and about 30 species out of 4,600 are associated with human habitats. About four species are well known as pests.
- 12. elongated metameric creatures with one pair of legs per body segment. Centipedes are known to be highly venomous, and often inject paralyzing venom
- 17. is a common name that is primarily applied to any one of numerous species of saltwater clams or marine bivalve mollusks in the taxonomic family Pectinidae
- 18. is used to refer to some decapod crustaceans, although the exact animals covered can vary.
- 19. free-swimming aquatic animals with a gelatinous umbrella-shaped
- 21. are nocturnal, but there are also crepuscular and diurnal species.
- 23. external parasites of mammals and birds, they live by consuming the blood of their hosts.
- 25. are small, spiny, globular animals that, with their close kin, such as sand dollars, constitute the class Echinoidea of the echinoderm phylum

- 26. like animals that naturally lack a shell, or have only an internal shell, are mostly called slugs, and land snails that have only a very small shell
 - 27. A pelagic marine mollusc of the cephalopod family nautilidae
 - 30. A crustacean with a broad carapace that move sideways or obliquely
 - 31. small crustaceans of the order euphausiacea, and are found in all the world's oceans
 - 33. eusocial insect that are classified at the taxonomic rank of infraorder Isoptera
 - 36. marine arthropods of the family Limulidae and order Xiphosura or Xiphosurida
 - 37. Is applied over 200 ant species, in different lineages, due to their aggressive predatory foraging groups
 - 38. A marine echinoderm with five or more radiating arms
 - 39. they are a diverse animal phylum inhabiting a broad range of environments
 - 40. common name for several kinds of bivalve molluscs

- 1. Have specialized workers that are gorged with food by workers to the point that their abdomens swell enormously
 - 3. air-breathing arthropods that have eight legs and chelicerae with fangs that inject venom
 - 4. share a citellum and are hermaphrodites
 - 7. a group of insects that form the order Coleoptera, in the superorder Endopterygota

- 8. a group of arthropods that are characterised by having two pairs of jointed legs on most body segments
- 10. Has two eyes and four pairs of arms
- 11. they have triangular heads with bulging eyes supported on flexible necks
- 13. an insect belonging to the order Odonata infra-order Anisoptera.
- 14. a genus of small planktonic crustaceans, are 0.2-5 millimetres
- 15. are the larval stage of members of the order Lepidoptera
- 16. are insects in the macrolepidopteran clade Rhopalocera from the order Lepidoptera

- 22. A group of large and often hair arachnids belonging to the Theraphosidae
- 24. obligate parasites, living externally on warm-blooded hosts which include every species of bird and mammal, except for monotremes, pangolins, bats and cetaceans
- 28. small arachnids, part of the order Parasitiformes
- 29. are the basalmost clade of animals of the phylum Porifera
- 32. Are parasitic insects of the cimicid family that feed exclusively on blood
- 34. worm found in the phylum Annelids commonly found living in soil, feeding on live and dead organic matter.
