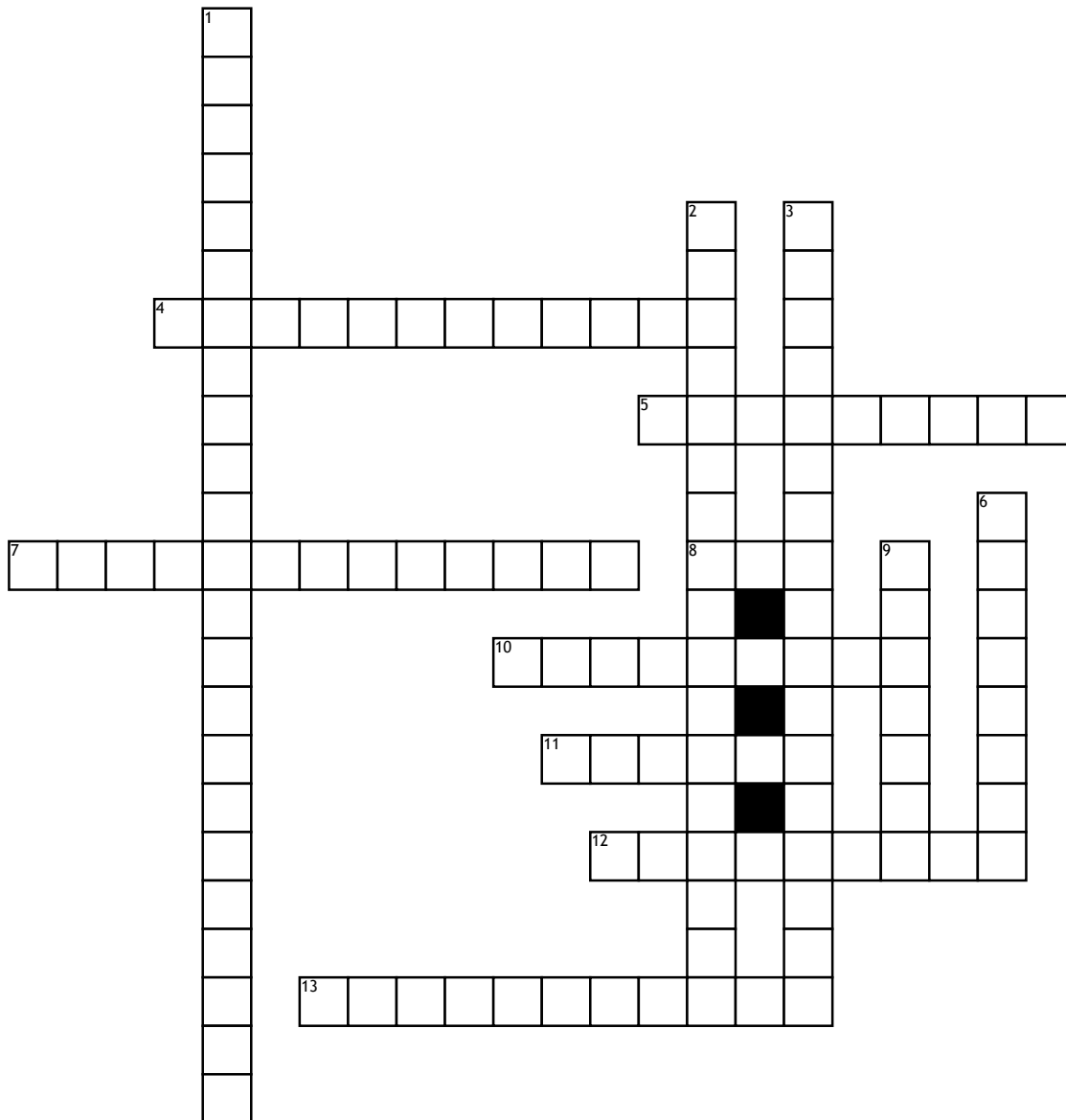

4. Purple, planar, polygonal, pruritic, plaques and papules

5. Known IVDU, abnormal LFT's, systemic itch

7. Patient reports systemic itch. U/E you notice Goitre, exophthalmos, slight tremor, thin hair and thin nails

8. no examination findings. abnormal U&E's show uraemia.

10. Itchy raised wheals due to vascular reaction

11. erythematous regions with excoriations in flexor surfaces

12. Salmon pink base with white scales located on extensor surfaces

13. Patient presents jaundice, pale stools, dark urine and a systemic itch

Down

1. Symmetrical blistering of skin filled with watery fluid (vesicles). Patient also reports steatorrhoea.

2. Patient reports itch in areas of skin which appear tight, erythematous and scaly

3. well circumscribed erythematous and pruritic region around a new watch

6. pustular rash in dermatomal regions. Patient reports severe pain and itch.

9. grey irregular track marks between fingers and toes. Crusted scabs also appear
