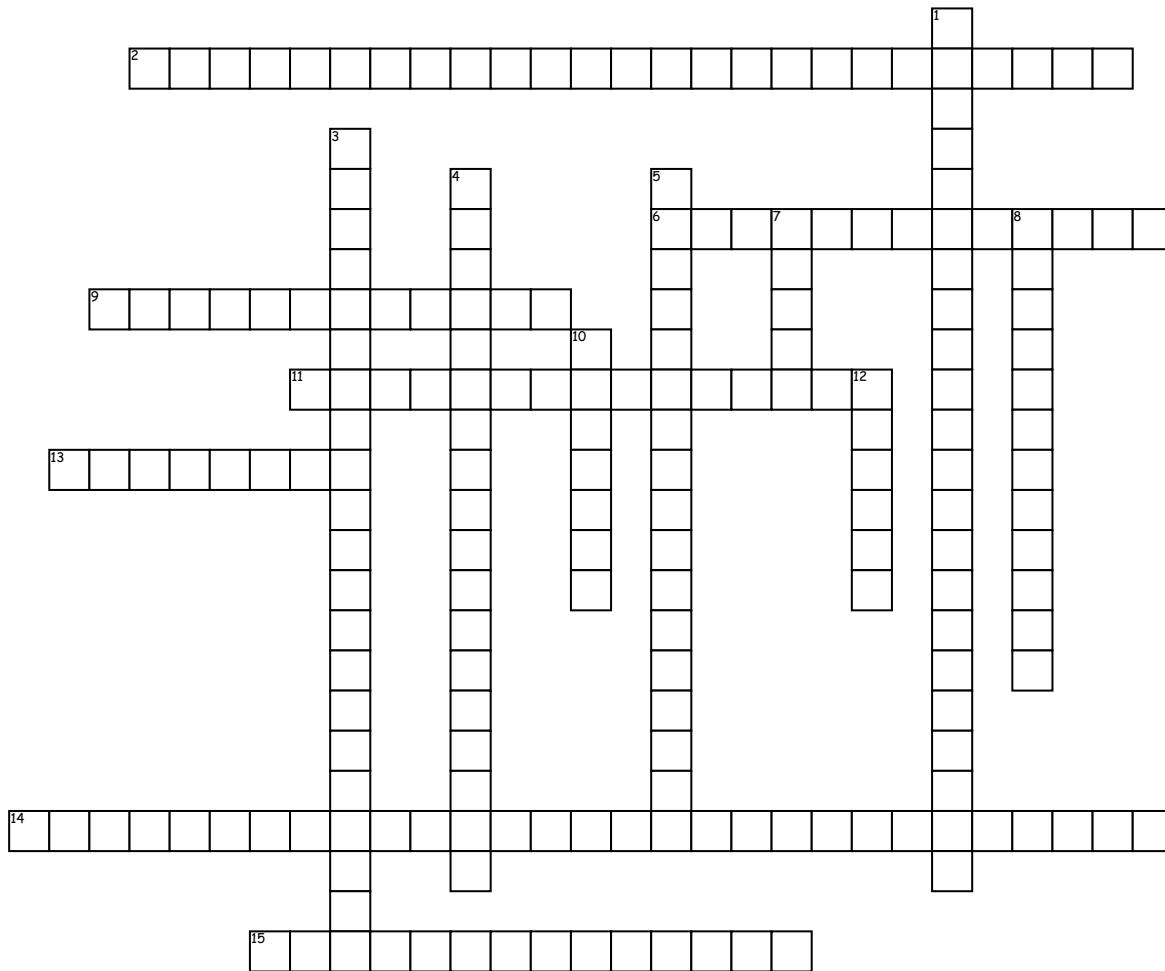


JOBS RELATING TO POLITICS
