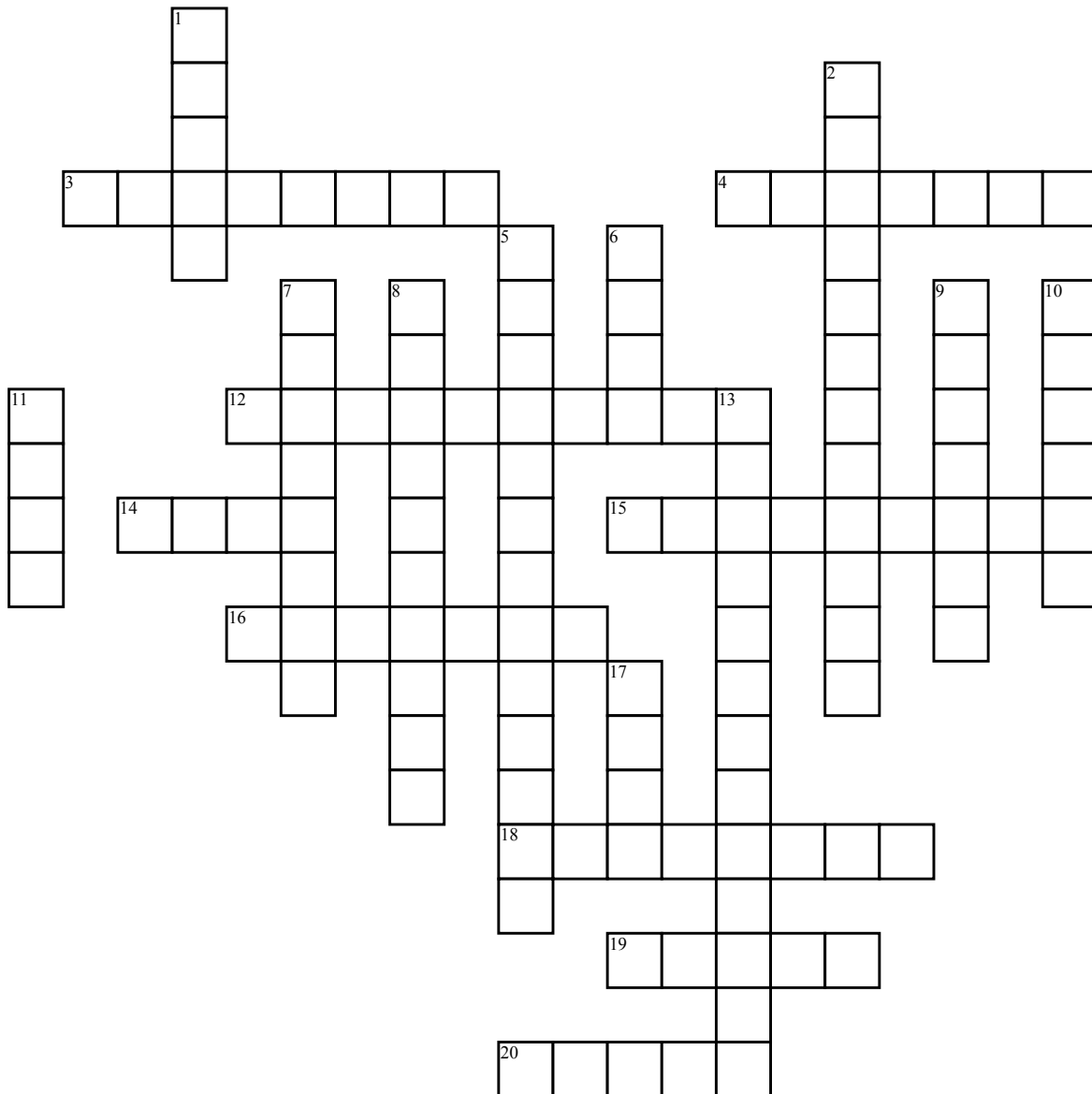


# Jamacia
