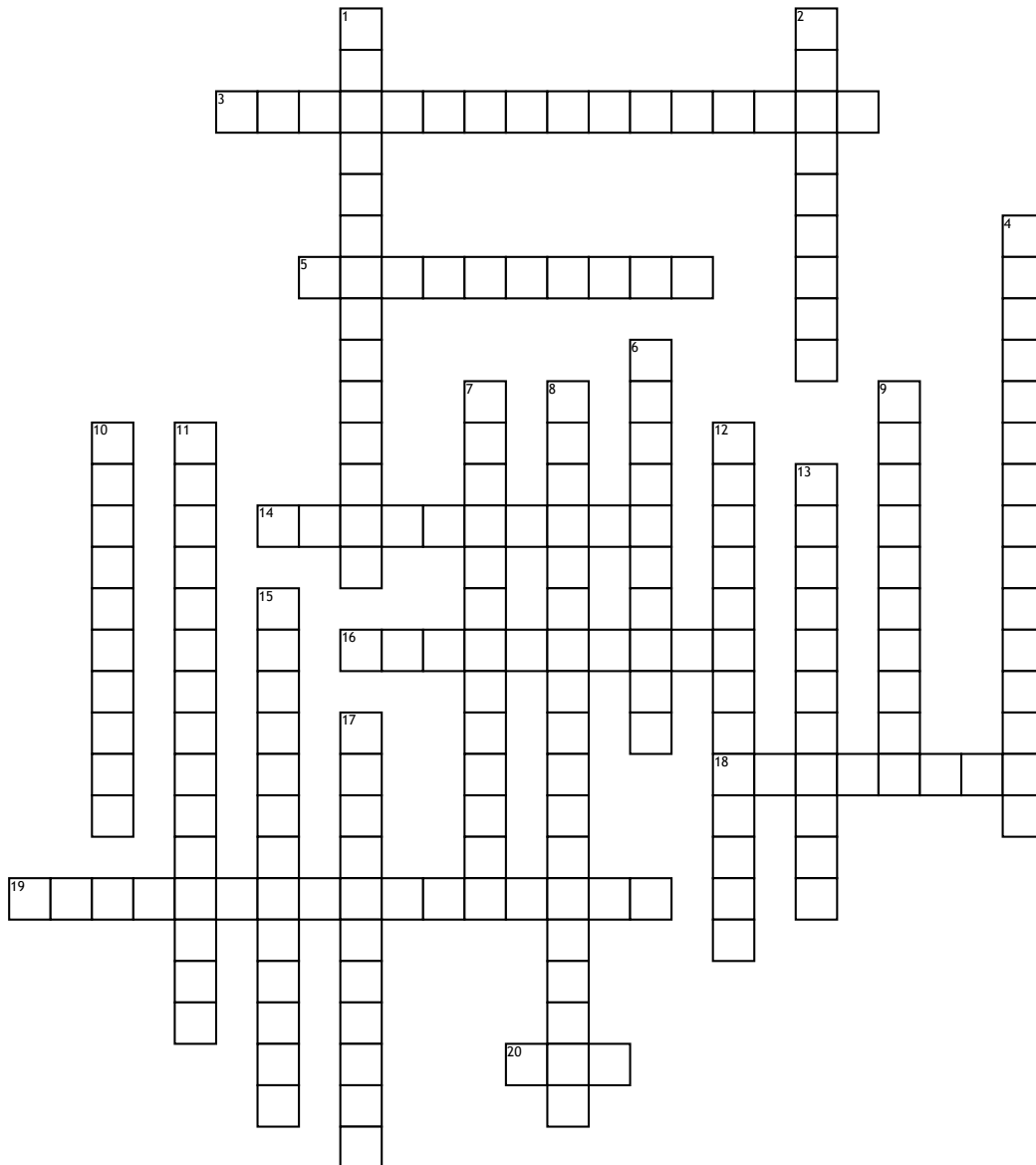


Jamari's CrossWord Puzzle #2
