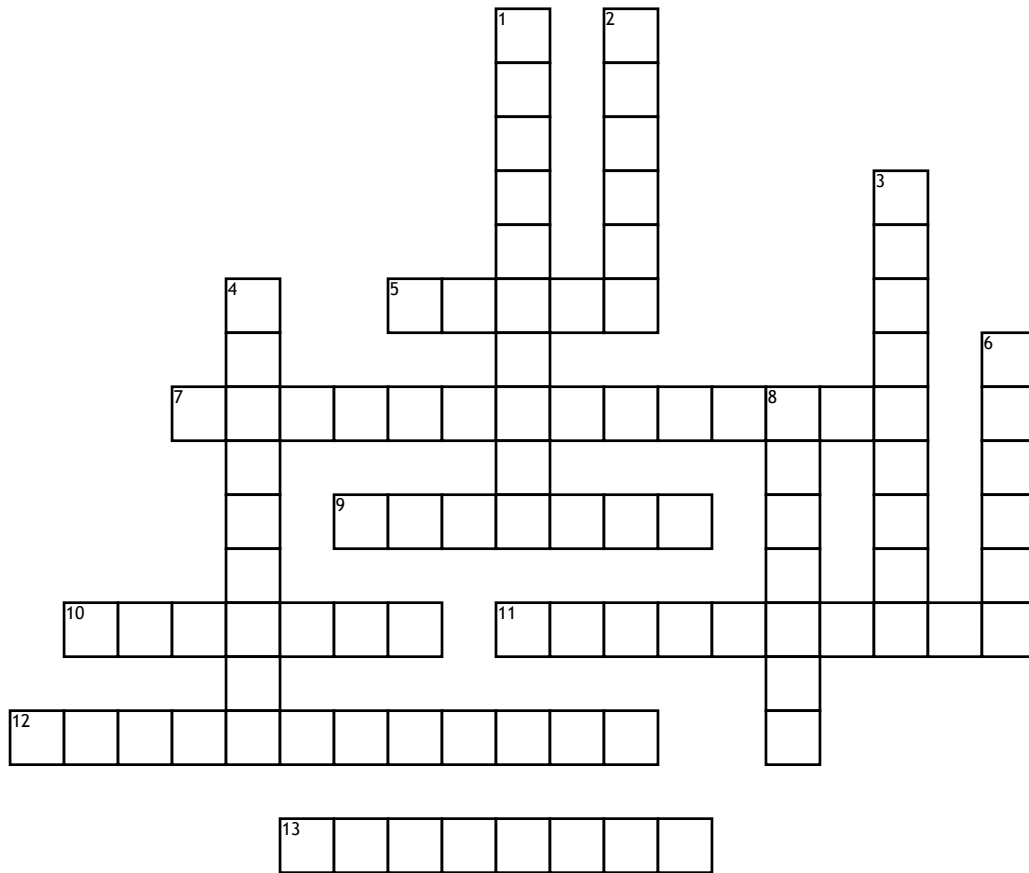


Jazz Vocabulary
