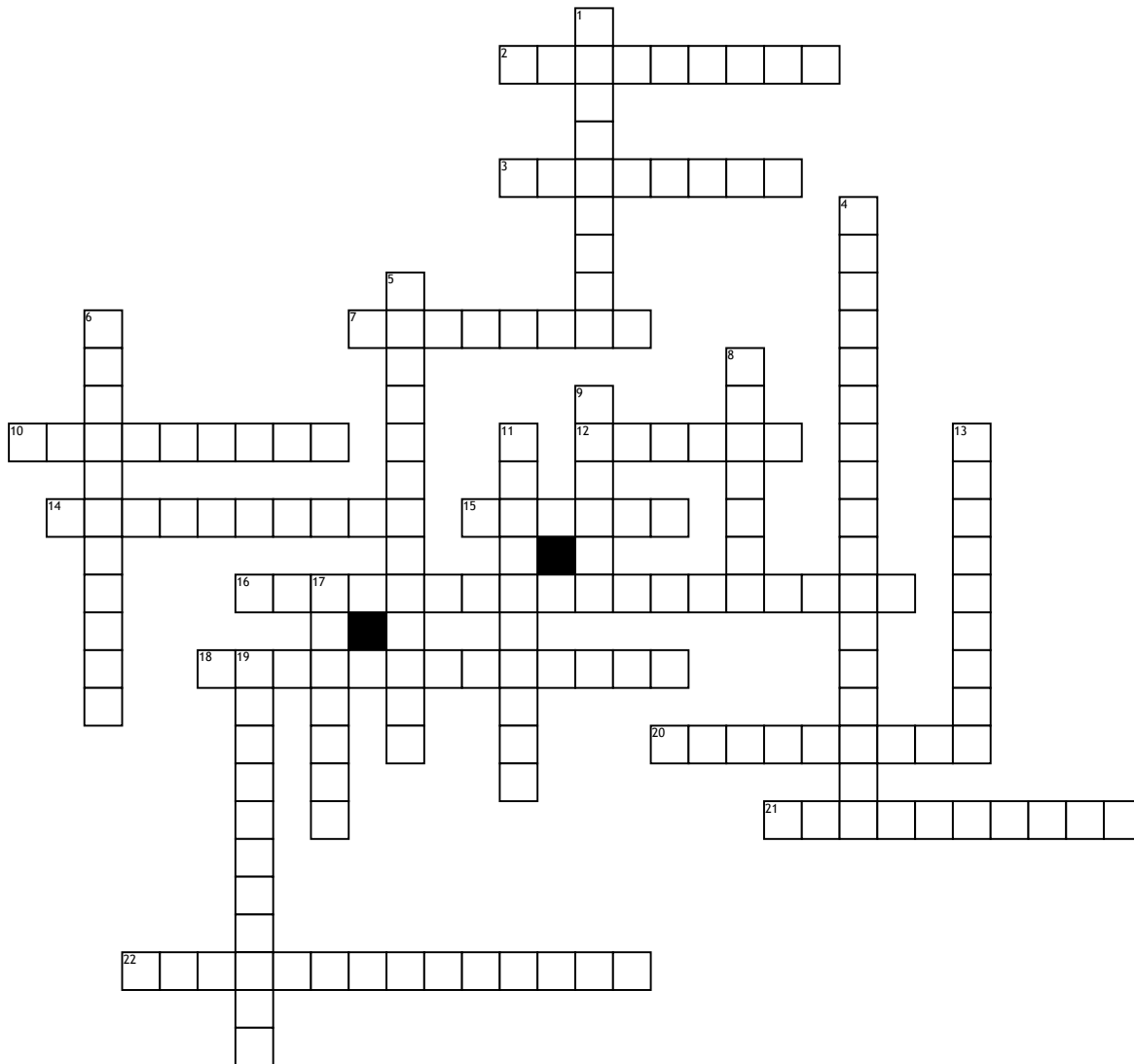

 18. Also known as the economy of salvation, this refers to God's eternal plan.

1. A term meaning "advocate" or "helper."
 4. A gathering of the Church's bishops from around the world convened by the pope.
 5. The judgement of the human race by Jesus Christ at his second coming.

6. The formal statement or profession of Christian belief originally formulated at the Council of Nicea in 325 and amplified at the Council of Constantinople in 381.
 8. Hebrew word for "anointed one."
 9. From the Greek translation of the Hebrew Messiah, meaning "anointed." It became the proper name for Jesus because he accomplished perfectly the divine mission of priest, prophet, and king.
 11. The study of human existence using logical reasoning.
 13. Also called the Mass or Lord's supper, and based on a word for "thanksgiving." It is the central Christian liturgical celebration
 17. From the Latin word trinus, "meaning threefold."
 19. From the Latin, meaning "to become flesh," referring to the mystery of Christ becoming man.
