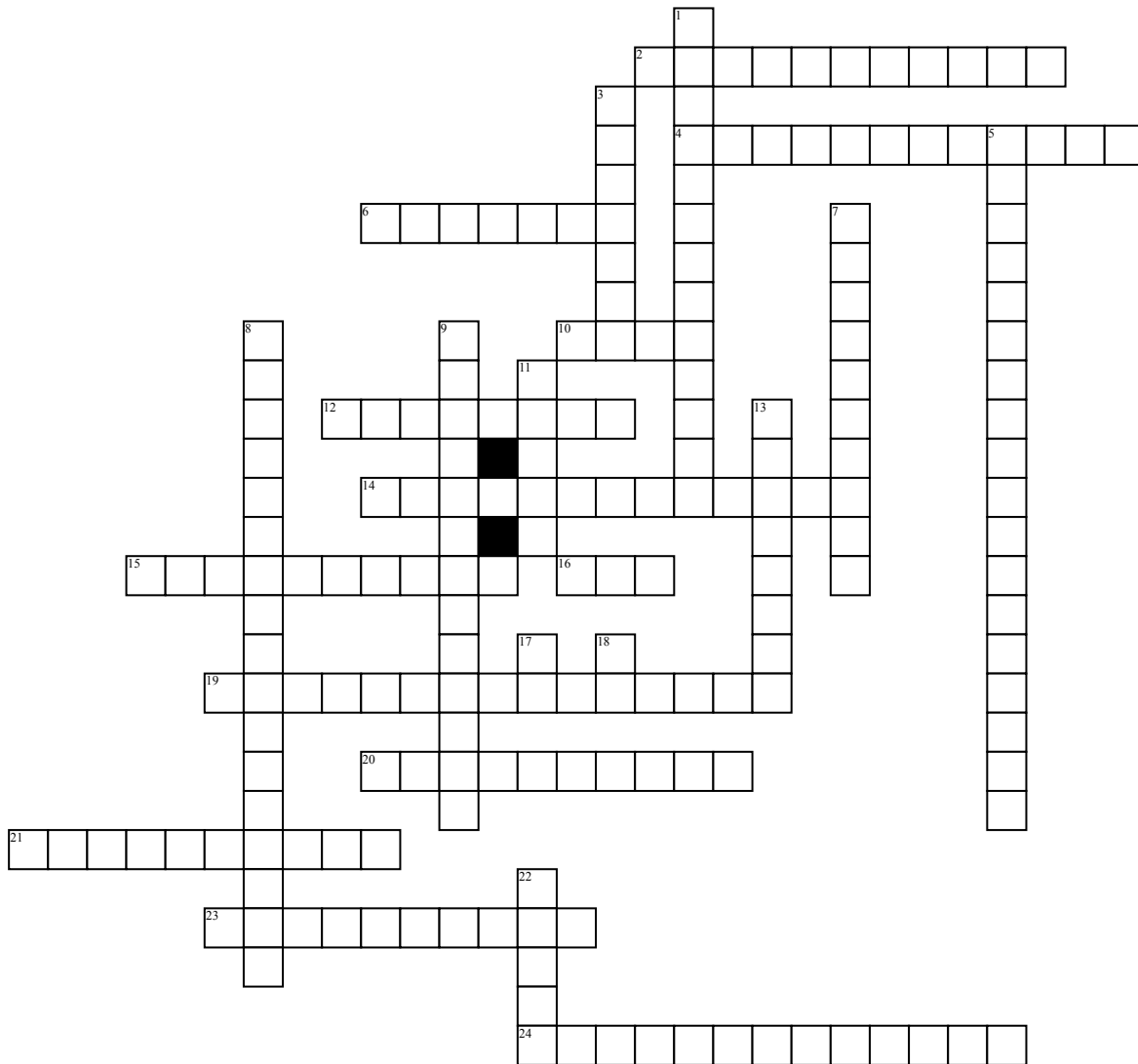


Jews in Nazi Germany - Metalanguage

 10. a group of people (Romani) that arrived in Europe in migrations from northern India around the 14th century
 12. the science of using controlled breeding or genetic manipulation to simply produce desired qualities or features
 14. Night of the Broken Glass, on 9 and 10 November 1938, when Jewish businesses and synagogues were attacked by the Nazis
 15. the deliberate ending of someone's life, usually for compassionate reasons
 16. Kraft durch Freude, meaning Strength through Joy; an organisation that provided Nazi leisure activities and holidays for people

19. the programme that brought 10,000 Jewish children to safety in 1938 and 1939

20. the spread of ideas, often one-sided, designed to influence people's opinions

21. when information, considered unsuitable, is removed from publications

23. passed on from parents to offspring through genes

1. the state of being confined, eg. in prison

3. Secret State Police; a ruthless organisation that aimed to eliminate political opponents and Jews in Nazi Germany

5. a prolonged economic downturn, beginning after the Wall Street Crash, that affected the whole world

7. a yellow symbol shaped in the Star of David used by the Nazis as a badge of shame for Jewish people

8. members of a Christian-based religious movement founded in the USA in the late 19th century

9. a permanent form of contraception which usually involves an operation to prevent a person from giving birth

11. a Romani people of Central Europe

13. someone who is completely opposed to any kind of violence and will not participate in any aspect of war

17. Storm Troopers or Brownshirts; a military style organisation of the Nazi party formed in 1921 under Hitler

18. The Schutzstaffel, also known as the Blackshirts; a German police/military style organisation created to serve as Hitler's bodyguards

22. person of European descent - not Jewish - often with blonde hair and blue eyes; the Nazis viewed Aryans as the superior human race
