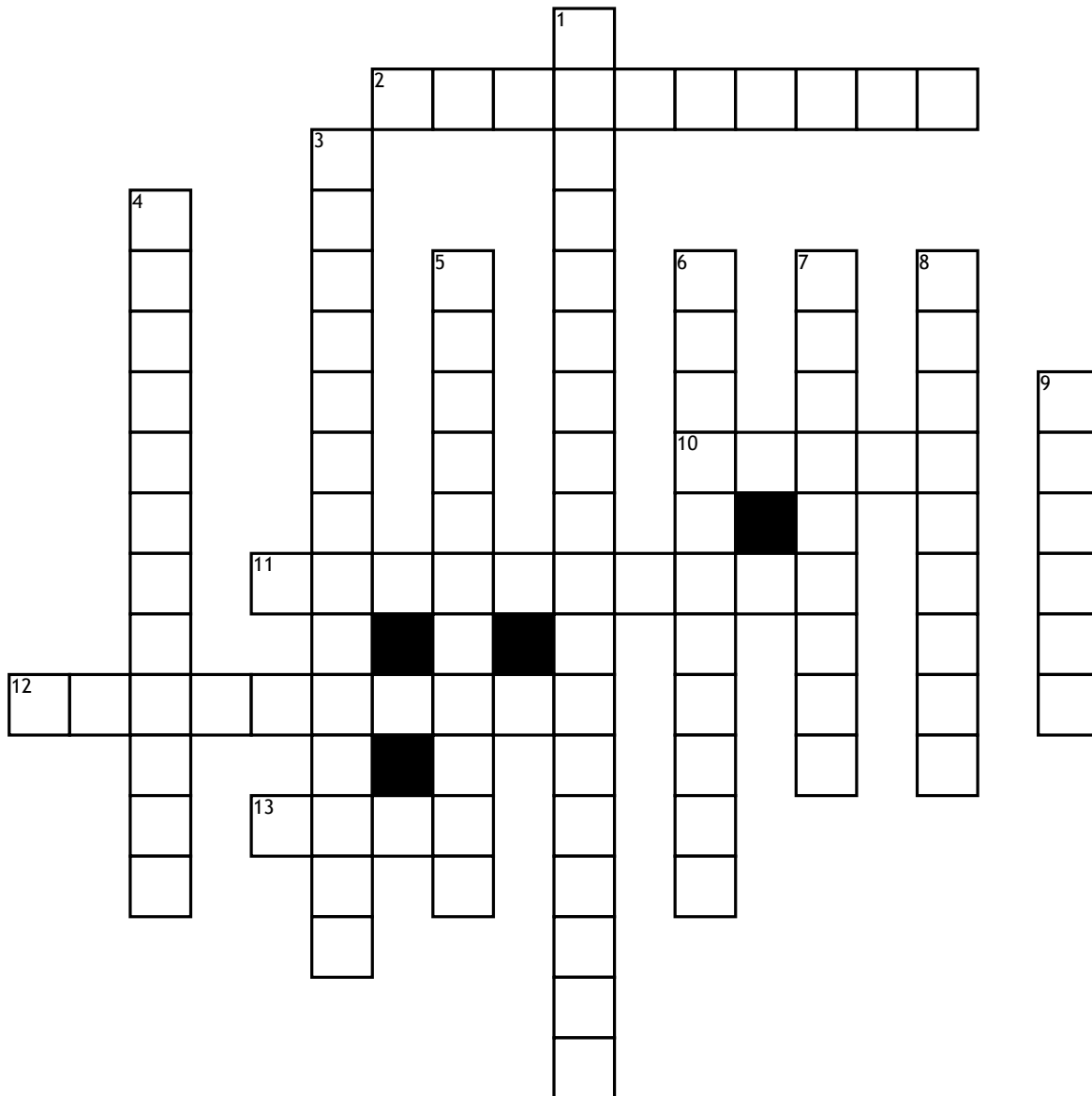


# Joseph Leadership Qualities
