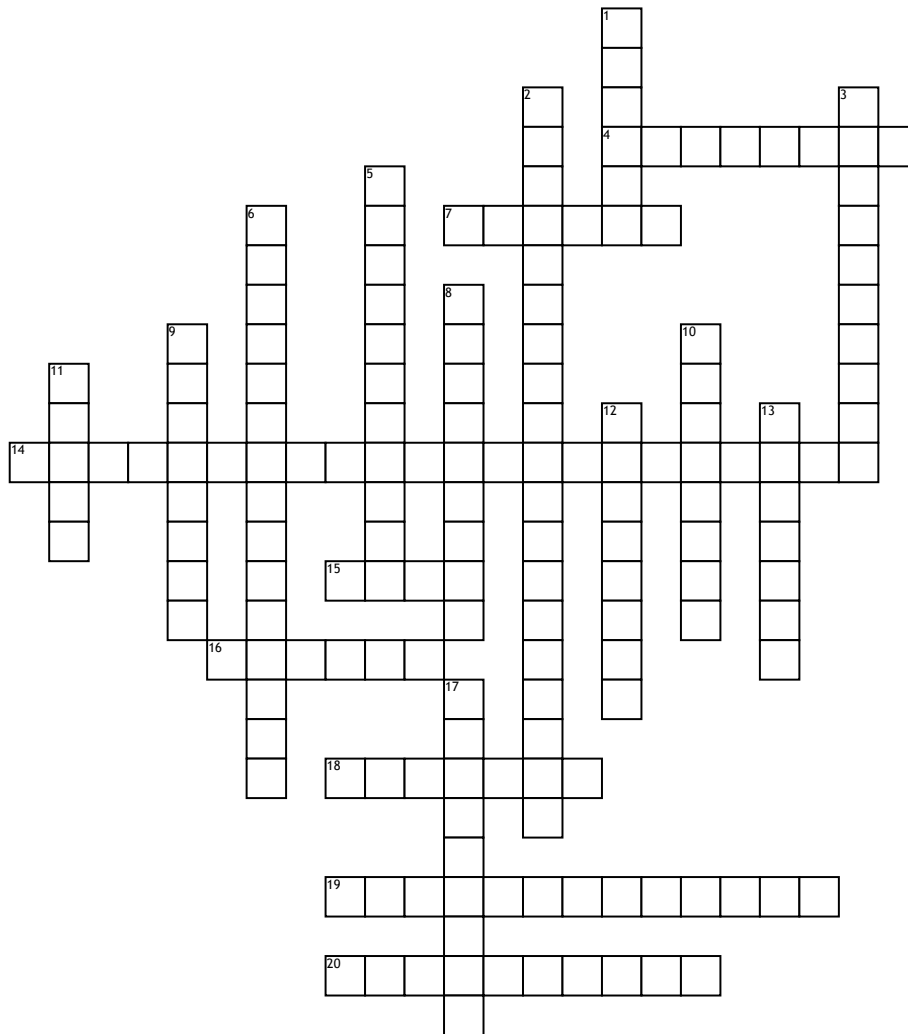

- 11. The law of god as revealed to Moses and recorded in the first five books of the Hebrew Scriptures
- 12. The scattering of Jews outside of Israel in both ancient and modern times
- 13. Religious or moral path that Jews must follow
- 17. The building where a Jewish assembly or congregation meets for religious worship and instruction
