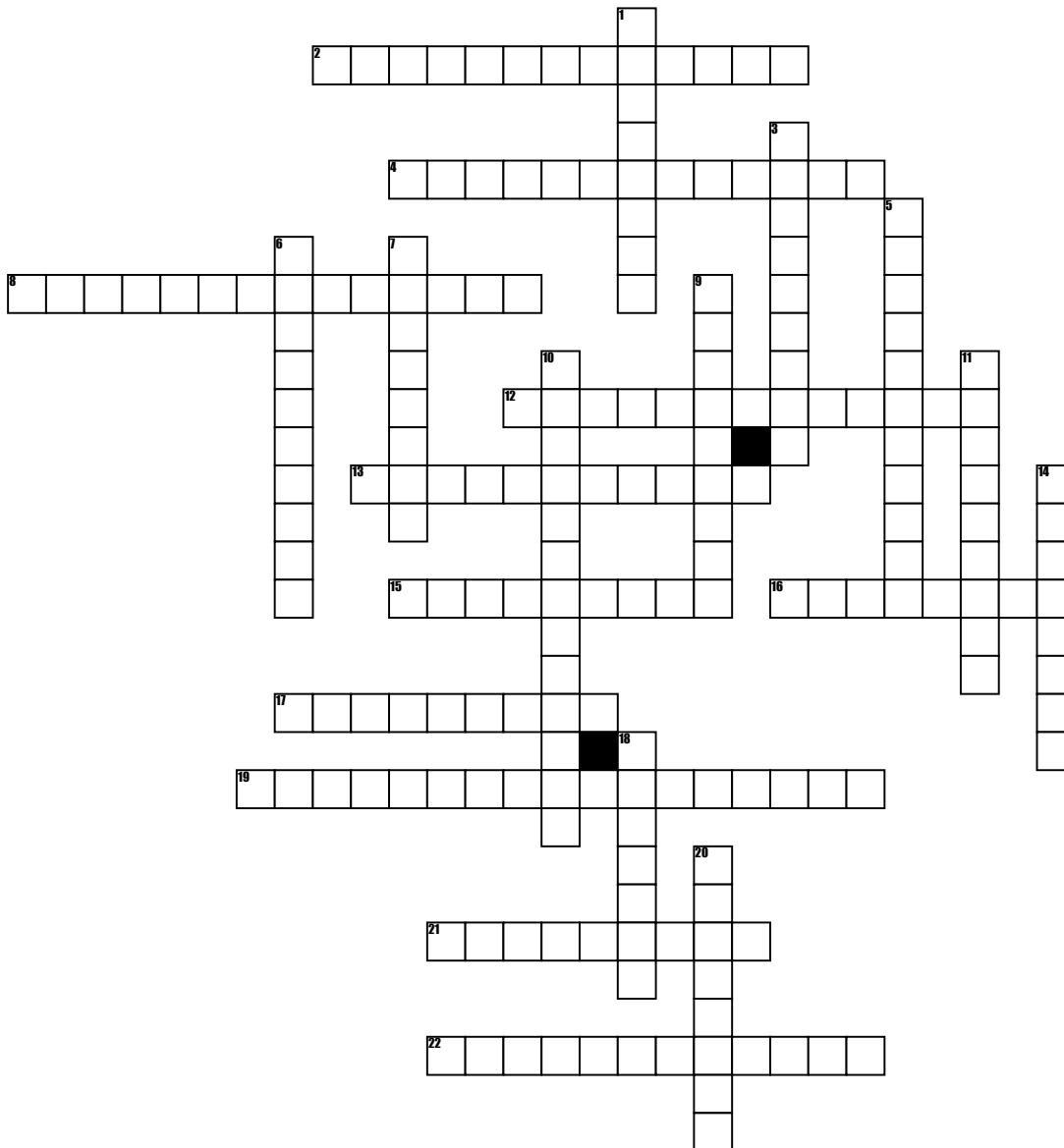


Kate's Crossword Puzzle
