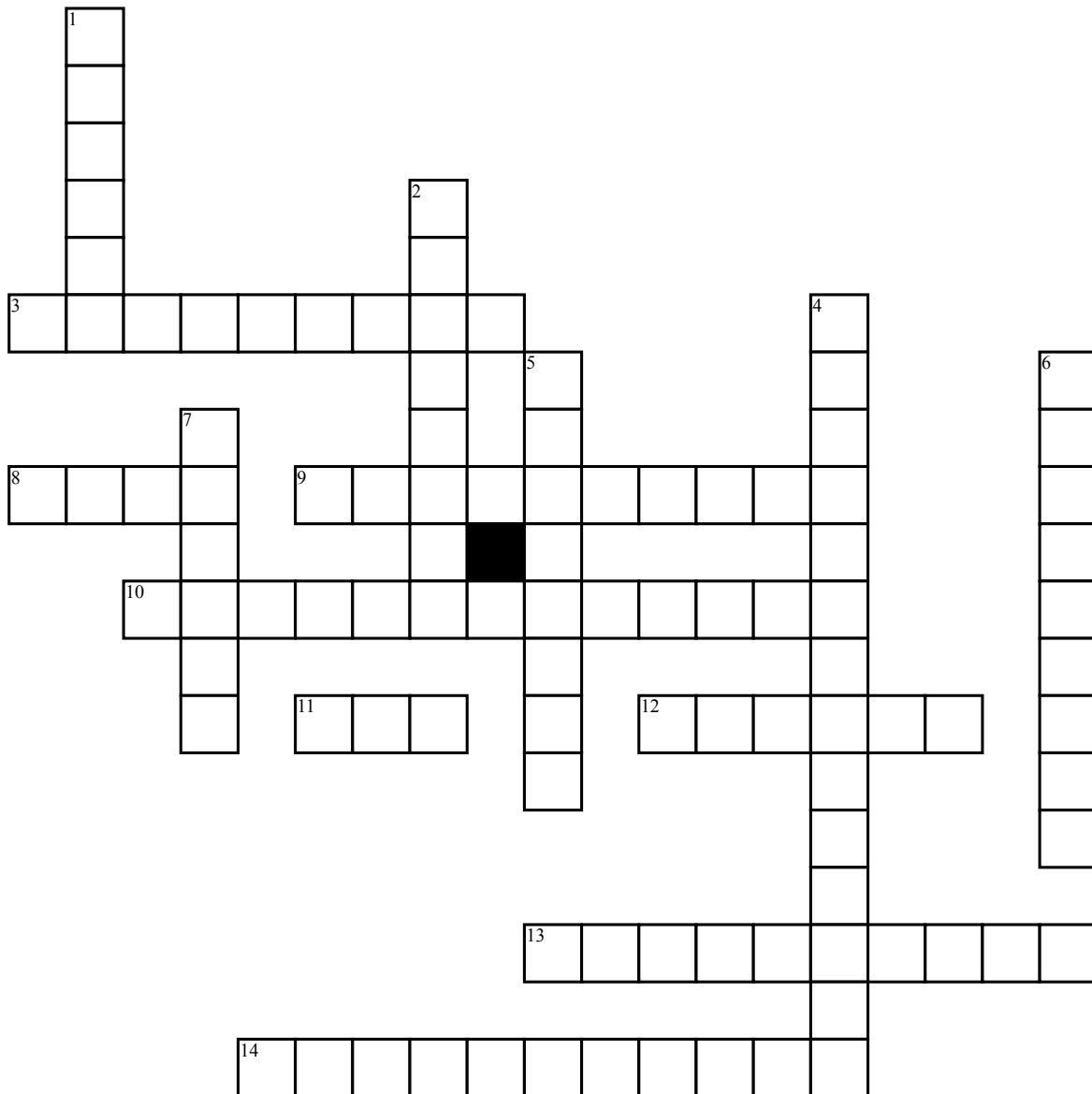


Keystone Definitions
