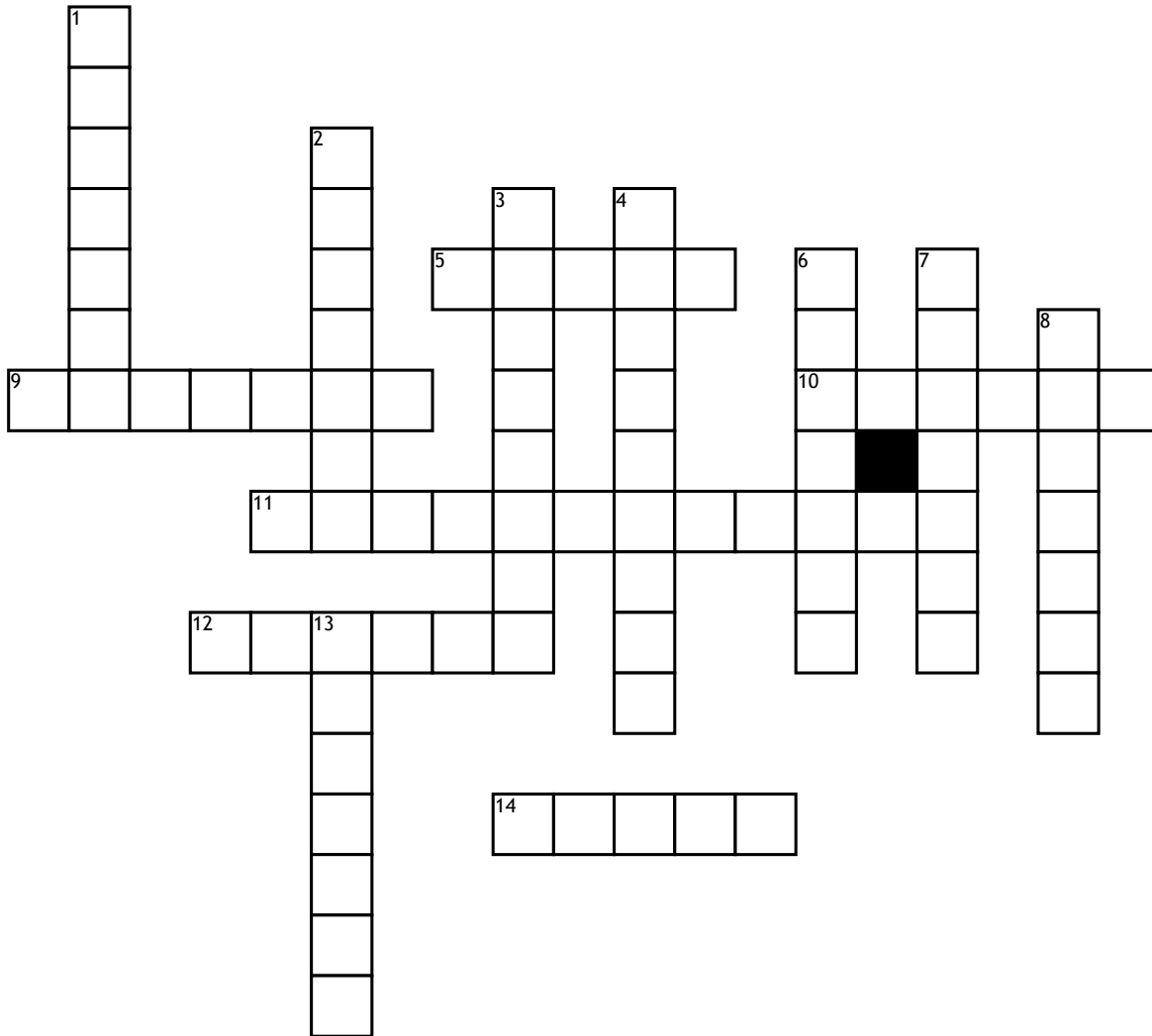


# Know the Masters
