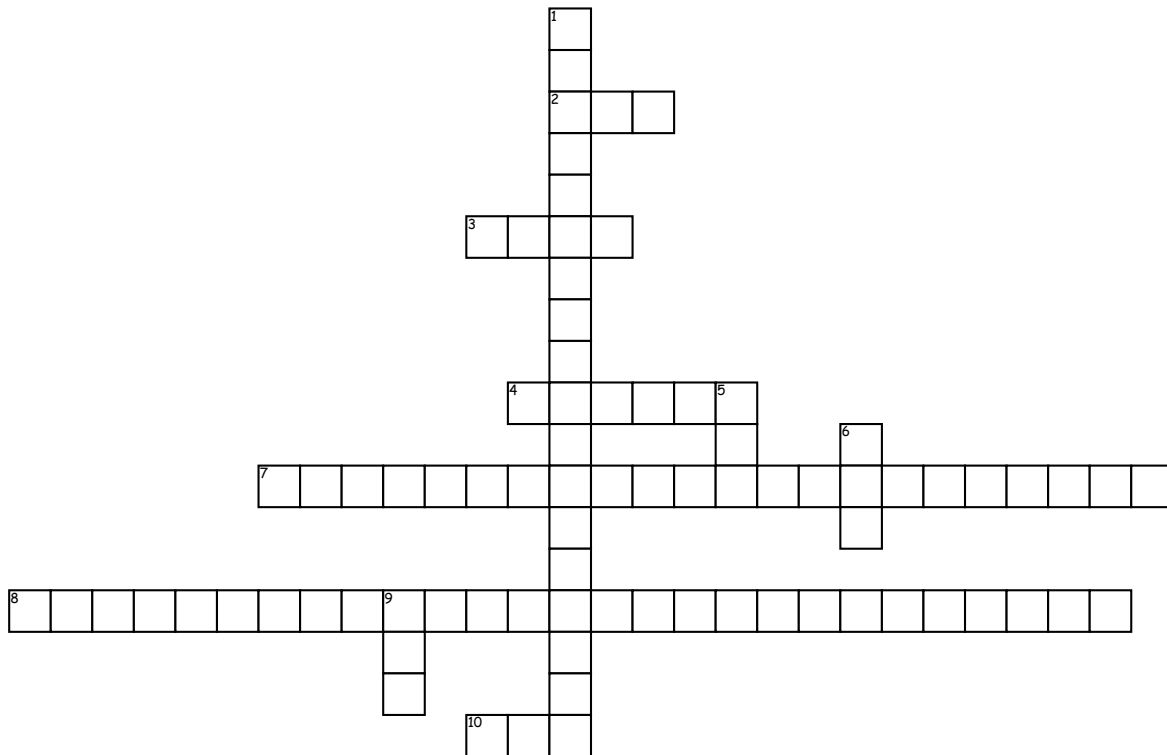


# LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENT COMMITTEE

2. This LPAC meeting takes place before State assessments tests.
3. This acronym is used for the group that must meet within the first 20 days of students enrolling.

7. Students with parents that have not agreed to ELL services will not receive this during State Testing such as STAAR
8. This assessment is used at all grade levels to determine placement of students into ELL or Bilingual programs.

1. Selecting anything other than English on this document requires language proficiency testing.
5. The number of years a student is monitored after being classified as NON-ELL
