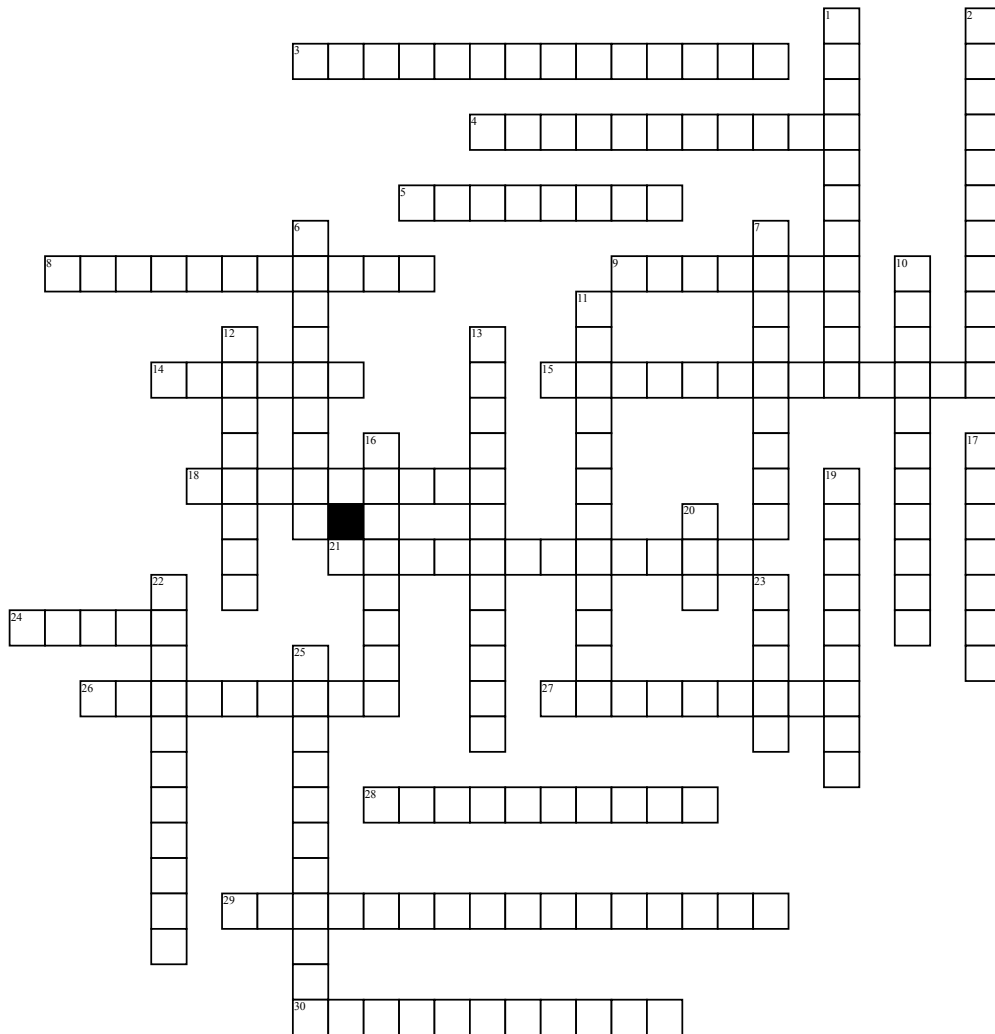

- 3. The sense of “being” male, female, genderqueer, agender, etc.
- 4. For a person who does not identify with either man or woman, but identifies with another gender.
- 5. An individual who is not open to themselves or others about their (queer) sexuality or gender identity.
- 8. Describes a person who keeps their sexual orientation or gender identity a secret from some or all people.
- 9. A woman who is primarily attracted to other women.
- 14. In voluntary or unwanted disclosure of another person’s sexual orientation, gender identity, or intersex status.
- 15. Relating to relationships or communication between people.
- 18. A curiosity about having attraction to people of the same gender/sex
- 21. A person who is only attracted to members of the opposite sex.
- 24. Used as an umbrella term to describe individuals who don’t identify as straight.
- 26. Have the capability of attraction to others regardless of their gender identity or biological sex.
- 27. Experiencing little or no romantic attraction to others and/or has a lack of interest in romantic relationships/behavior.

- 28. A range of negative attitudes and feelings toward homosexuality or people who are identified or perceived as being lesbian, gay, bisexual or transgender (LGBT).
 - 29. The external display of one’s gender, through a combination of dress, demeanor, social behavior, and other factors, generally made sense of on scales of masculinity and femininity.
 - 30. A person who does not identify with a single fixed gender; of or relating to a person having or expressing a fluid or unfixed gender identity.

- 1. Gender expression that has elements of both masculinity and femininity
 - 2. A person whose gender identity is different from their biological sex, who may undergo medical treatments to change their biological sex
 - 6. The process of acknowledging one’s sexual orientation and/or gender identity to other people.
 - 7. Types of gender identity where an individual’s experience of their own gender matches the sex they were assigned at birth.
 - 10. The fear and hatred of, or discomfort with, transgender people.

- 11. A person who merges characteristics of gender in subtle ways or intentionally
- 12. A person primarily emotionally, physically, and/or sexually attracted to people who are not their same sex/gender.
- 13. Someone who wears clothes of another gender/sex.
- 16. A person who is attracted to both people of their own gender and another gender. Also called “bi”
- 17. A person who generally does not feel sexual attraction or desire to any group of people.
- 19. What people use to attempt to tell the gender/sex of another person.
- 20. A person who is attracted primarily to members of the same sex
- 22. All people who do not identify with their assigned gender at birth or the binary gender system.
- 23. An acronym for “lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer.
- 25. For some, the process of exploring and discovering one’s own sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression.
