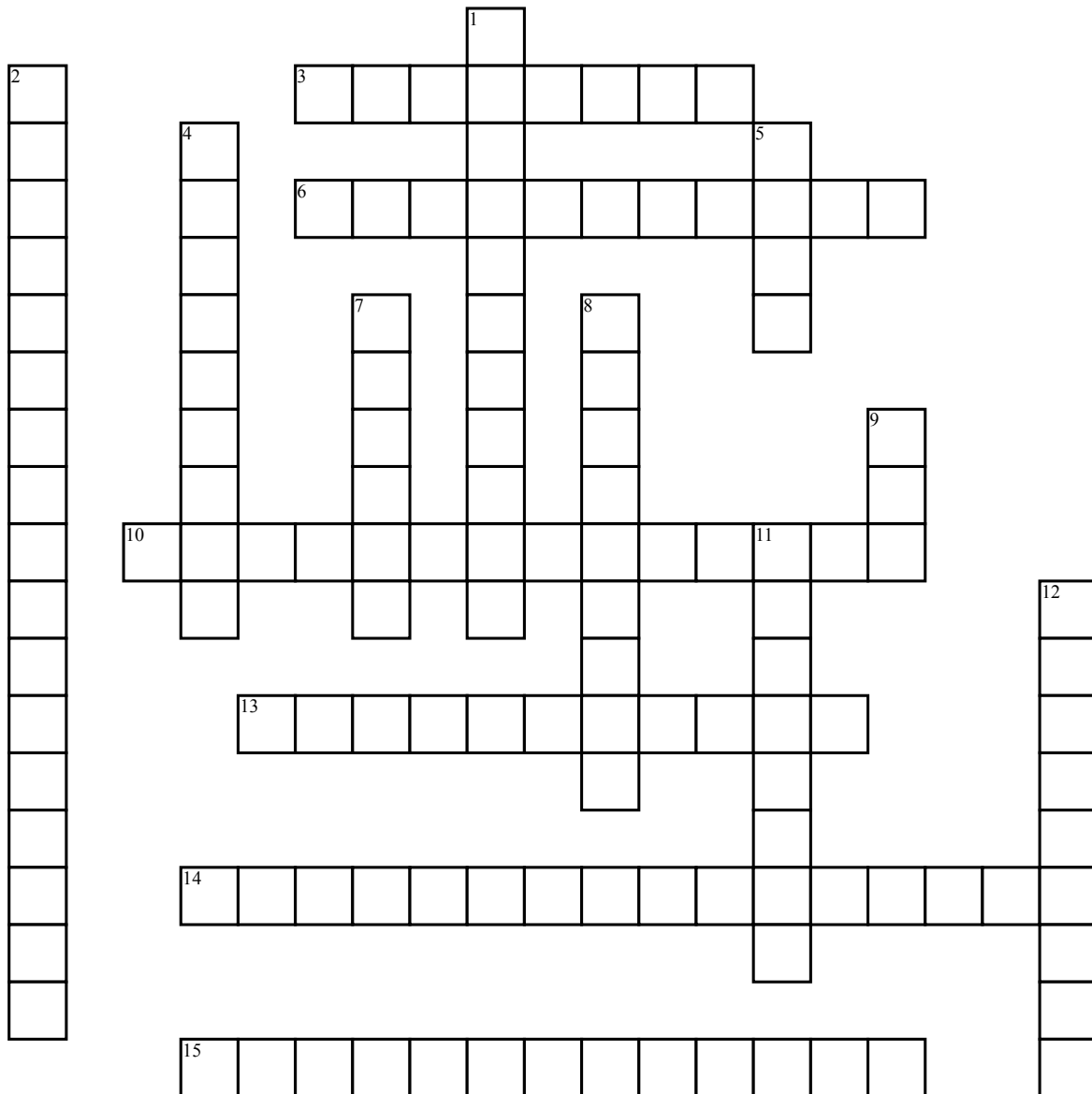


LGBTQ+ Terms

- 3. A person who is emotionally, romantically, or sexually attracted to more than one sex, gender, or gender identity
- 6. Social behaviors and expression that a culture expects from people based on their assigned sex (girls wear pink, boys don't cry)
- 10. A person's feelings of maleness, femaleness or a blend of both or neither. Can be the same or different from sex assigned at birth
- 13. People whose gender identity differs from the sex they were assigned at birth
- 14. External appearance of one's gender identity, usually expressed through behavior, clothing, haircut

15. Medical classification that refers to physiological, genetic or physical attributes that determines if a person is assigned male, female or intersex at birth

Down

- 1. A person who does not identify with a single fixed gender and whose identification may shift
- 2. Emotional, romantic, or sexual attraction to other people
- 4. A person whose gender identity aligns with the sex assigned at birth
- 5. A person who does not identify as LGBTQ, but expresses solidarity with and advocates for LGBTQ people
- 7. Social, physical, psychological and emotional traits that classify a person as feminine, masculine, androgynous or other
- 8. Referring to someone in a way that does not correctly reflect the gender with which they identify

- 9. A term used to describe people who are physically or romantically attracted to a person of the same sex or gender identity
- 11. A term describing people born with sexual anatomy that cannot be classified as typical male or female
- 12. A person who does not assume two opposing parts (male/female or man/woman)
