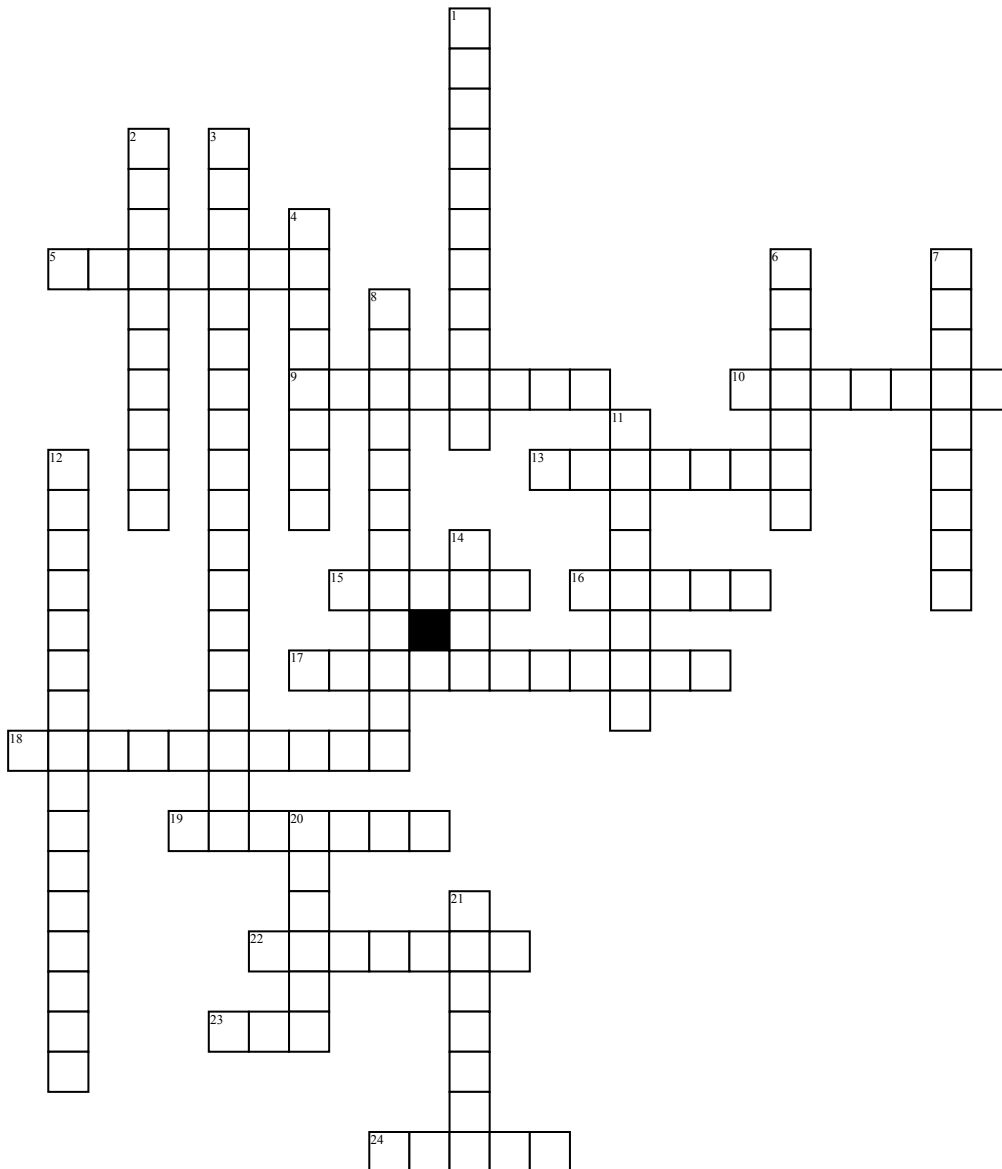


# LITERARY TERMS, ELEMENTS, & DEVICES DEFINITIONS
