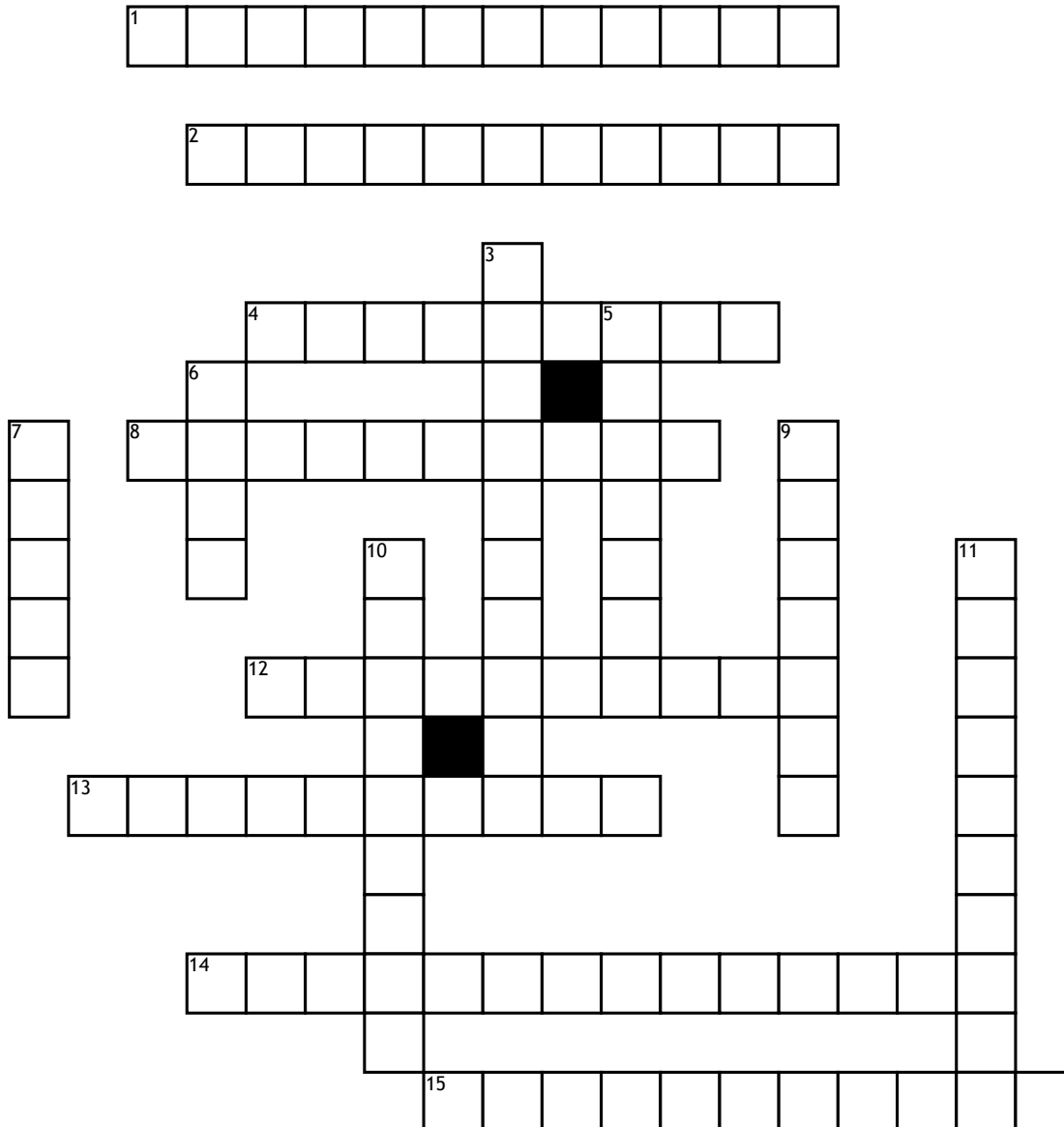

# LIVER PATHOLOGY



## Across

- 1. Pressure from outside the biliary system such as mass on the pancreatic head
- 2. Intense pain upon palpation of the gallbladder
- 4. Mimics gallbladder filled with cholelithiasis
- 8. Most common form of neoplastic
- 12. Type of shunts placed MPV to IVC

- 13. Obstruction of hepatic veins, "enlarged" caudate lobe, atrophy of right and left lobes
- 14. Jaundice in pediatrics
- 15. Type of cyst that causes dilation of duct due to pancreatic juice reflux

## Down

- 3. Most common benign liver tumor
- 5. Benign tissue, young women on birth control pills

- 6. Spread through blood or plasma
- 7. Non shadow, non-mobile, echogenic
- 9. Ectasia of the intrahepatic ducts
- 10. Most common portal hypertension
- 11. Pus within the gallbladder
