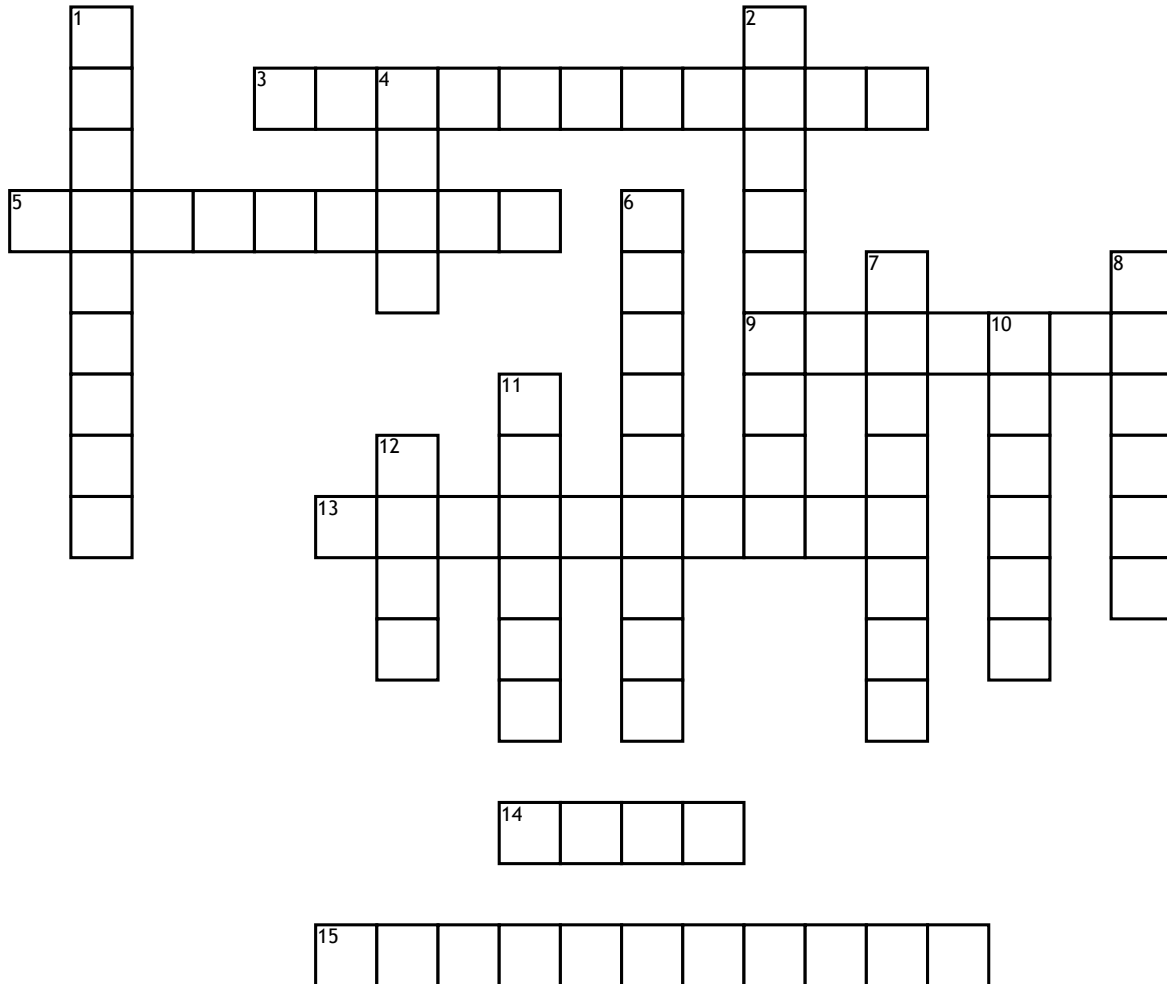

- 1. a written or printed statement made under oath
- 2. to separate from outside influences, such as jury
- 4. the defendant's statement of "guilty" or "not guilty"
- 6. jury verdict that a criminal defendant is not guilty

- 7. number of cases handled by a judge or court

- 8. a written account of the proceedings in a case
- 10. appellate court agrees with lower court decision and allows it to stand
- 11. serious criminal offense, usually punishable by one year or more in jail
