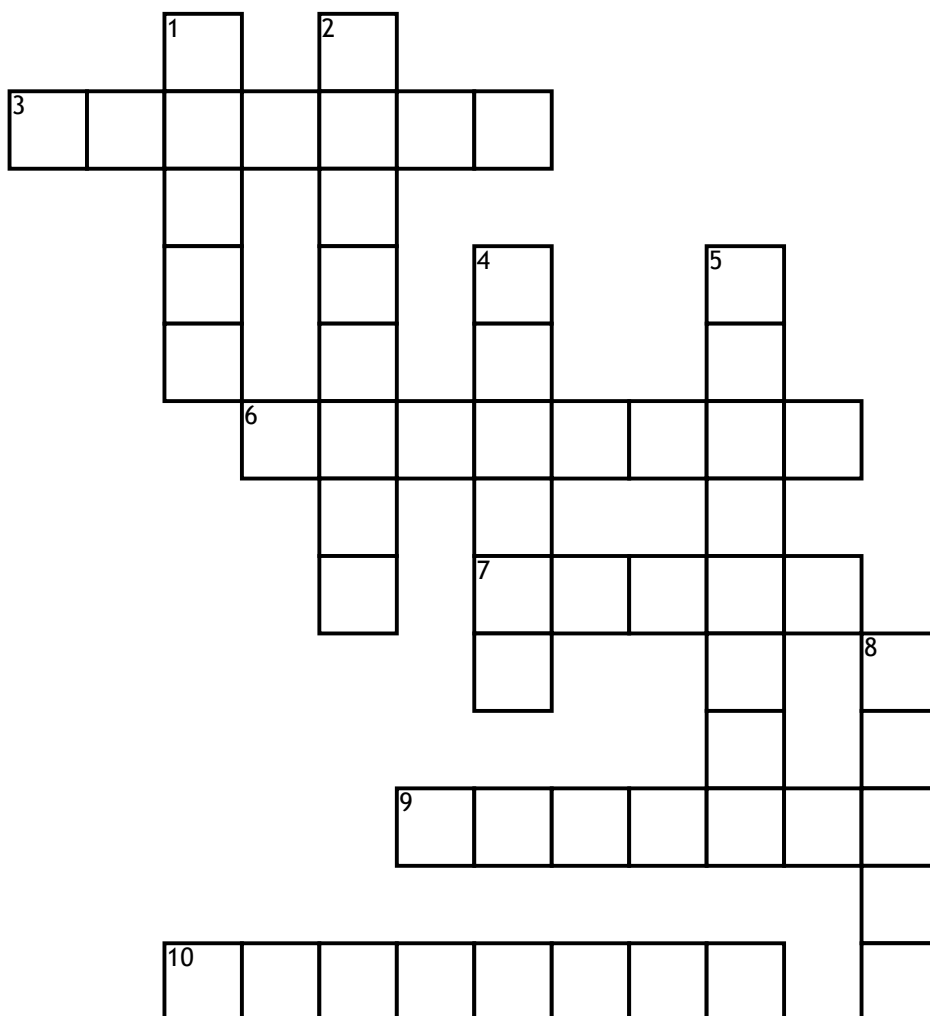

Lakes of Leitrim 3.

3. This is a prime fishing lake about 4 miles out the Cavan road from Ballinamore
 6. This lake is situated south of Killegar
 7. This accessible and good fishing lake is along the N4 on your left just after the Drumsna fly-over.
 9. This newly developed 2.7km walk around this lake lead around the lake and uphill to a point where you can see views of the adjoining 5 counties.
 10. This 60 acre lake along the N4 , 5 miles east of Carrick-on-Shannon holds tench ,roach , pike and bream.

Down

1. This large limestone lake which lies partly within Leitrim, Sligo and Roscommom supports the breeding Great Crested Grebe and the Tufted duck and it is home to the protected otter.
 2. This lake is situated north east of Glenboy.
 4. A sluice was used from the 18th century from this lake to reserve a water supply for the nearby cornmill situated in Kilclaremore townland .
 5. This small, shallow lake is situated about a mile east of the village of Drumsna.
 8. This lake is north east of Foxfield and south east of Saint John's lough.
