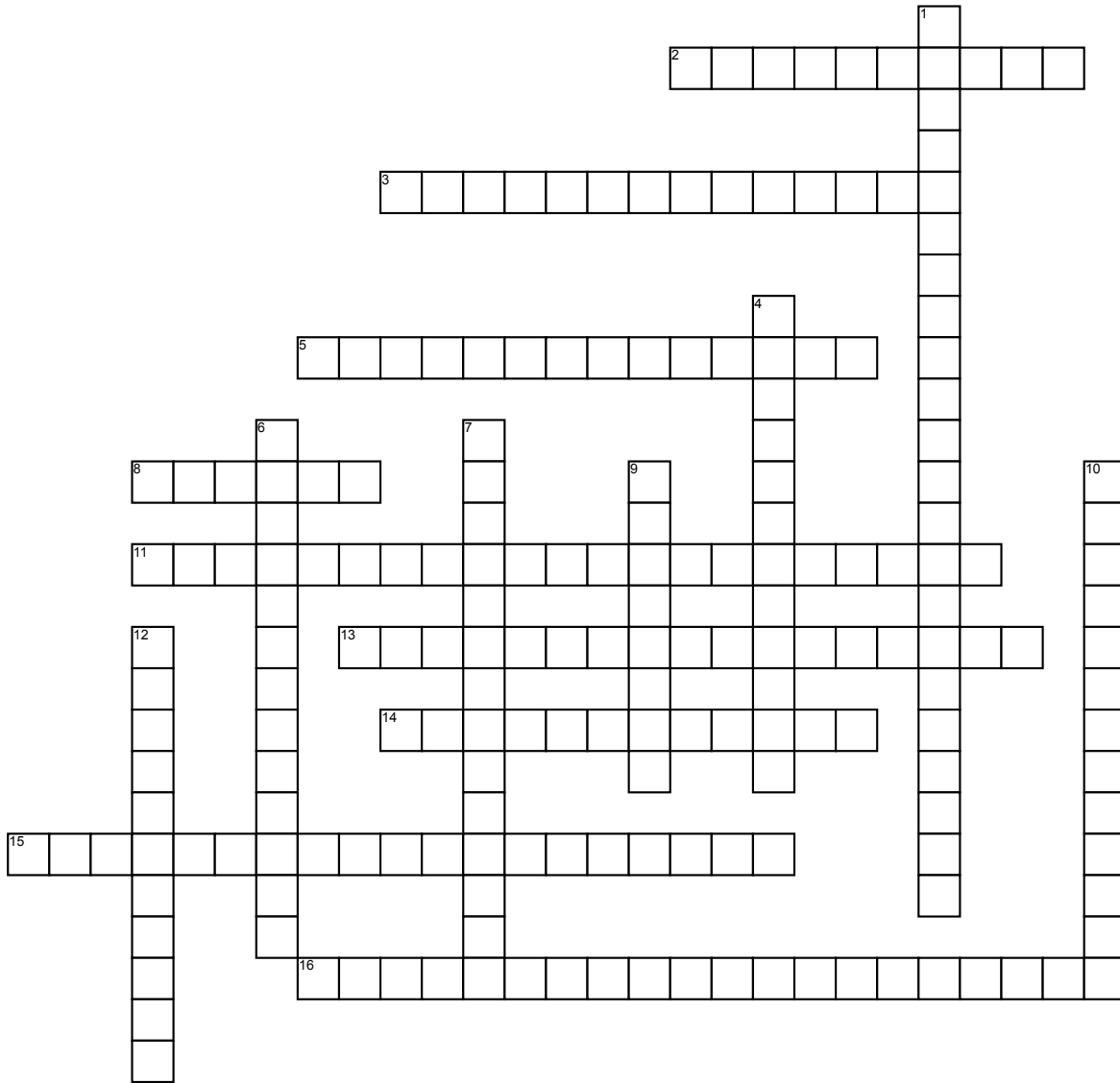

- 11. Defines who has access to to what waters resources

- 14. Started out as linear villages then officials organised the growth in grid formation
