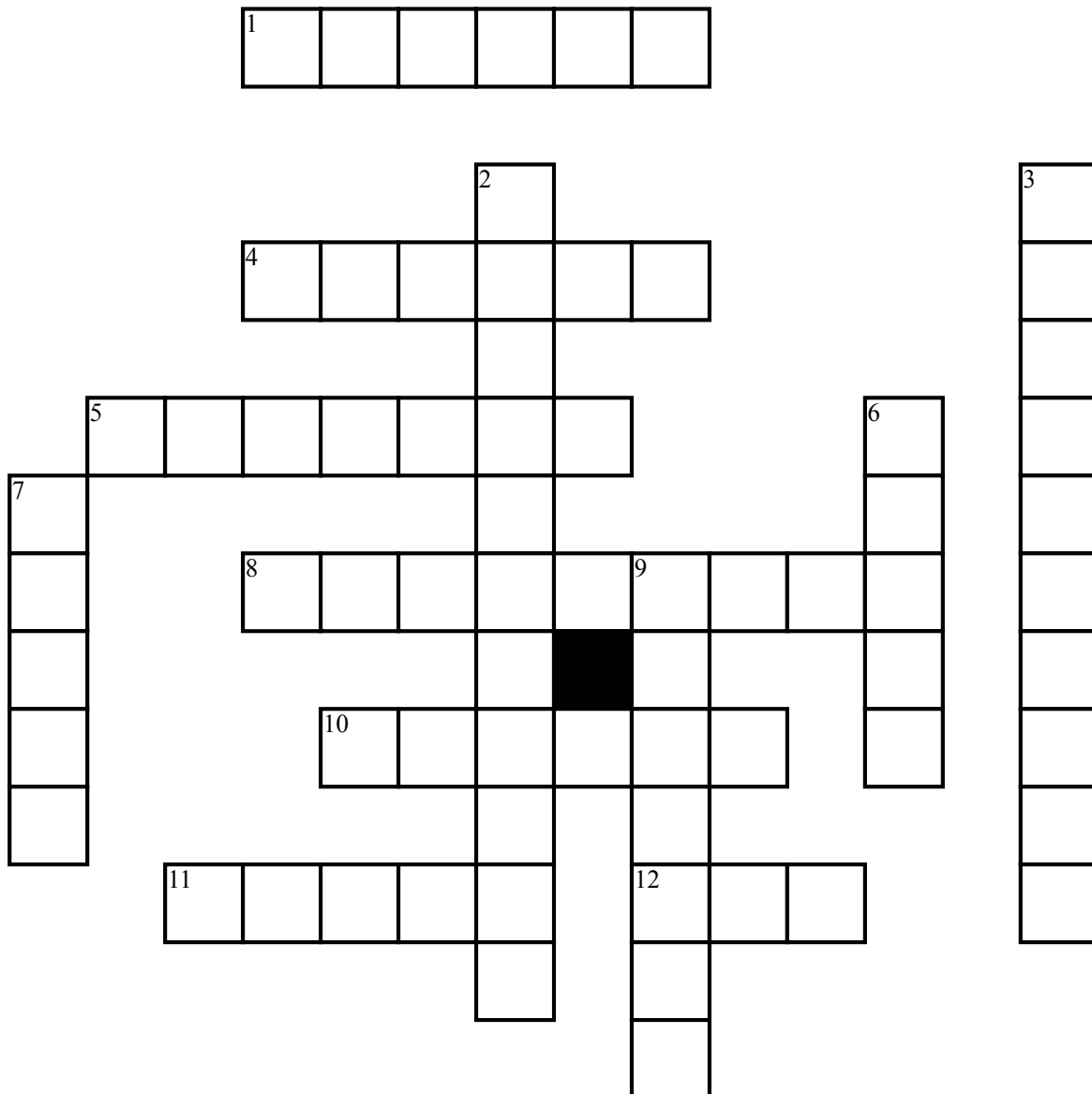


Landforms

1. A deep, narrow valley cut by a river through rock and surrounded by tall cliffs.
4. A low area of land between hills or mountains, typically with a river or stream flowing through it.
5. A narrow strip of land with sea on either side, forming a link between two larger areas of land
8. A body of land surrounded by water on three sides.

10. Any land area surrounded entirely by water.

11. A wetland area with ridges, which forms as a river water empties into a larger body of water.

12. A kind of wetland with wet, spongy soil.

2. A fan shaped deposit of soil and rocks, which forms where a fast flowing river spreads out over a flat plain.

3. A point of high land that juts out into a large body of water.

6. The area where the sea and land meet.

7. A dip in the Earth's surface shaped like a bowl with higher sides than the bottom. They can be oval or circular in shape and sometimes are filled with water.

9. A ridge of sand built up by currents.
