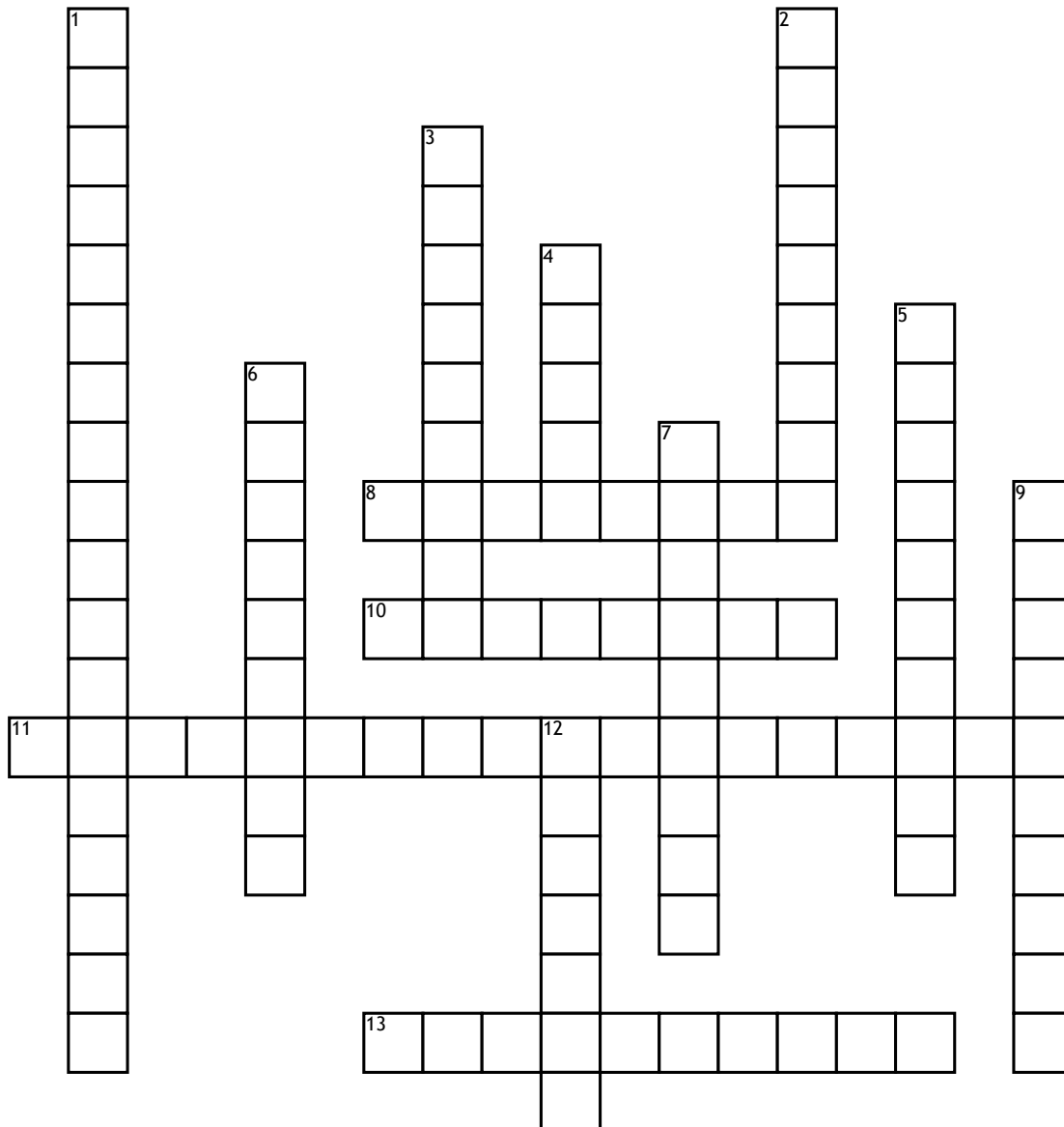

- 6. A chemical change in which a substance combines with oxygen as when iron oxidizes forming rust
