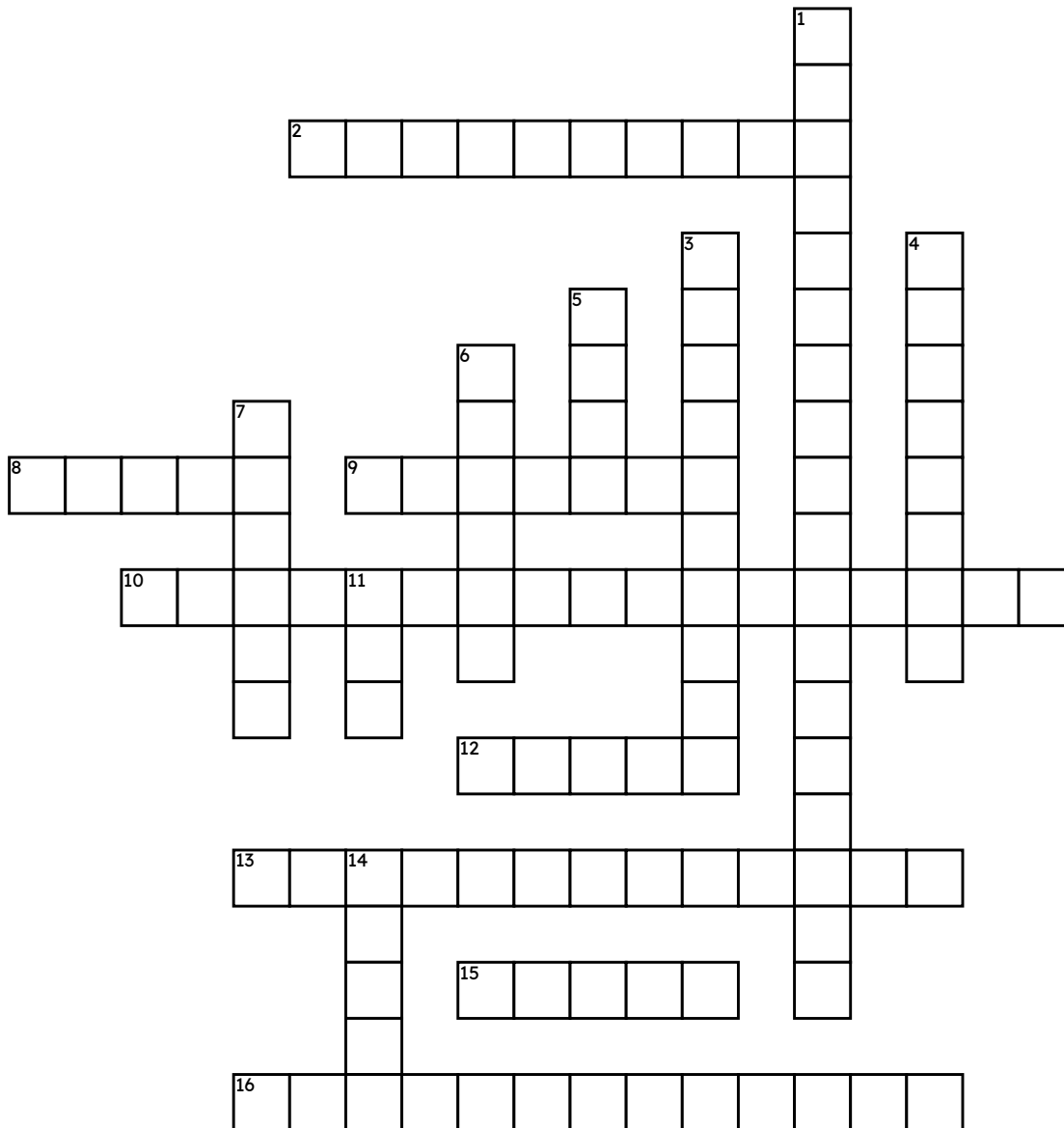


# Language of Geometry

- 2. A device used for measuring and drawing angles, usually shaped in a half circle and marked with degrees
- 8. A FLAT surface made up of points and extends indefinitely in all directions
- 9. A measurable part of a line consisting of two endpoints
- 10. Lines that intersect at a point or a set of points
- 12. The intersection of two rays at an endpoint
- 13. Two lines that NEVER intersect

  - 16. An angle with a degree measure of 180 degrees

  - 4. A point that divides a segment into two congruent segments
  - 5. It is made up of points with no thickness nor width
