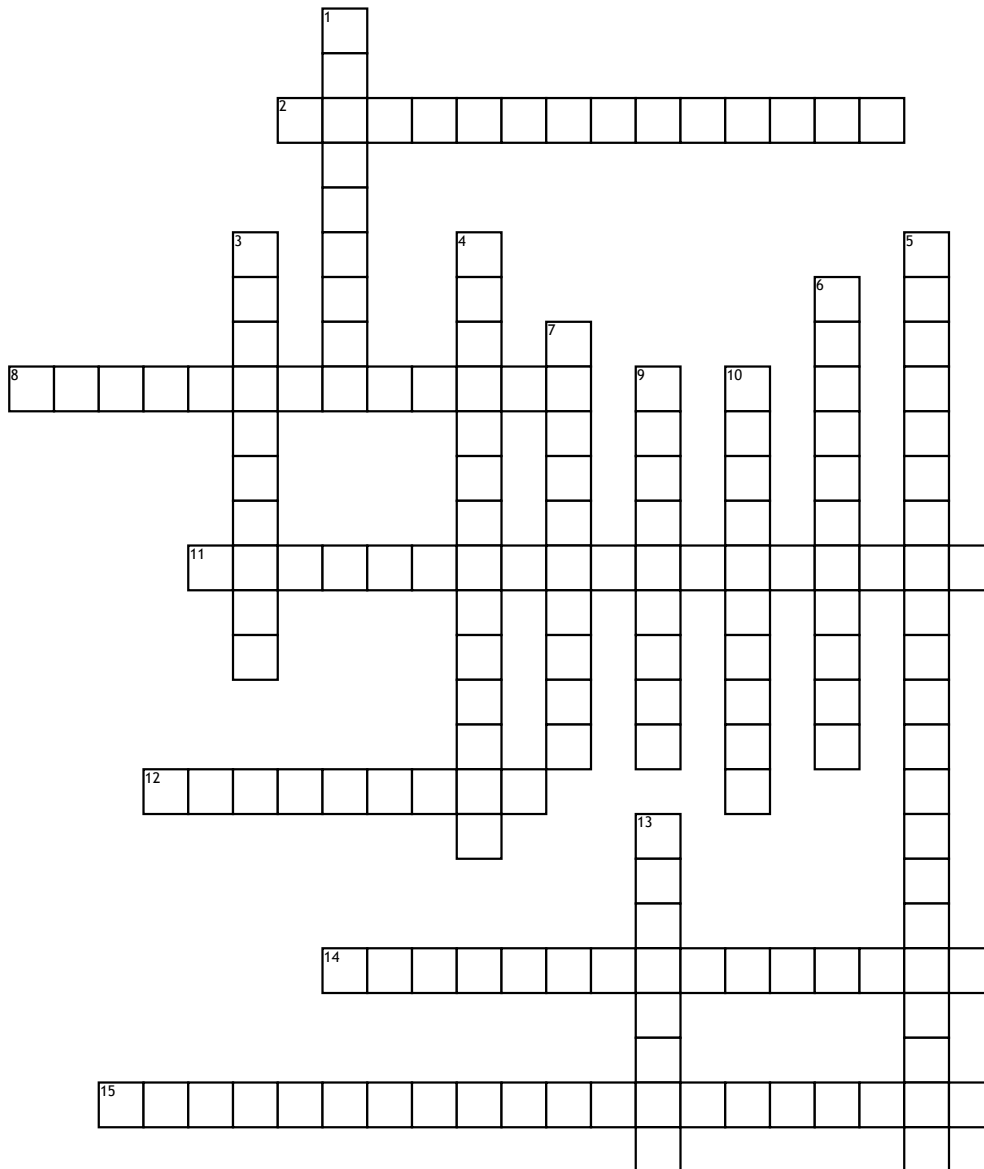

- 1. A private school supported and controlled by a religious organization
- 3. one of the provisions of the U.S. Constitution enacted after the original Constitution became law; an addition or change to an existing doc. or plan
- 4. a method used by courts to determine whether to restrict or punish expression based on its potential to cause immediate unlawful behavior
- 5. Used by courts to protect basic freedoms by making sure that gov. does not violate a fundamental right w/o good reason

- 6. Of or relating to the criminal corrections process
- 7. written or spoken expression about a person that is false and damages that person's reputation
- 9. A general term applying to anything that is immoral, indecent, or lewd
- 10. the idea stated in the 5th and 14th amendments that every person involved in a legal dispute is entitled to a fair hearing or trial
