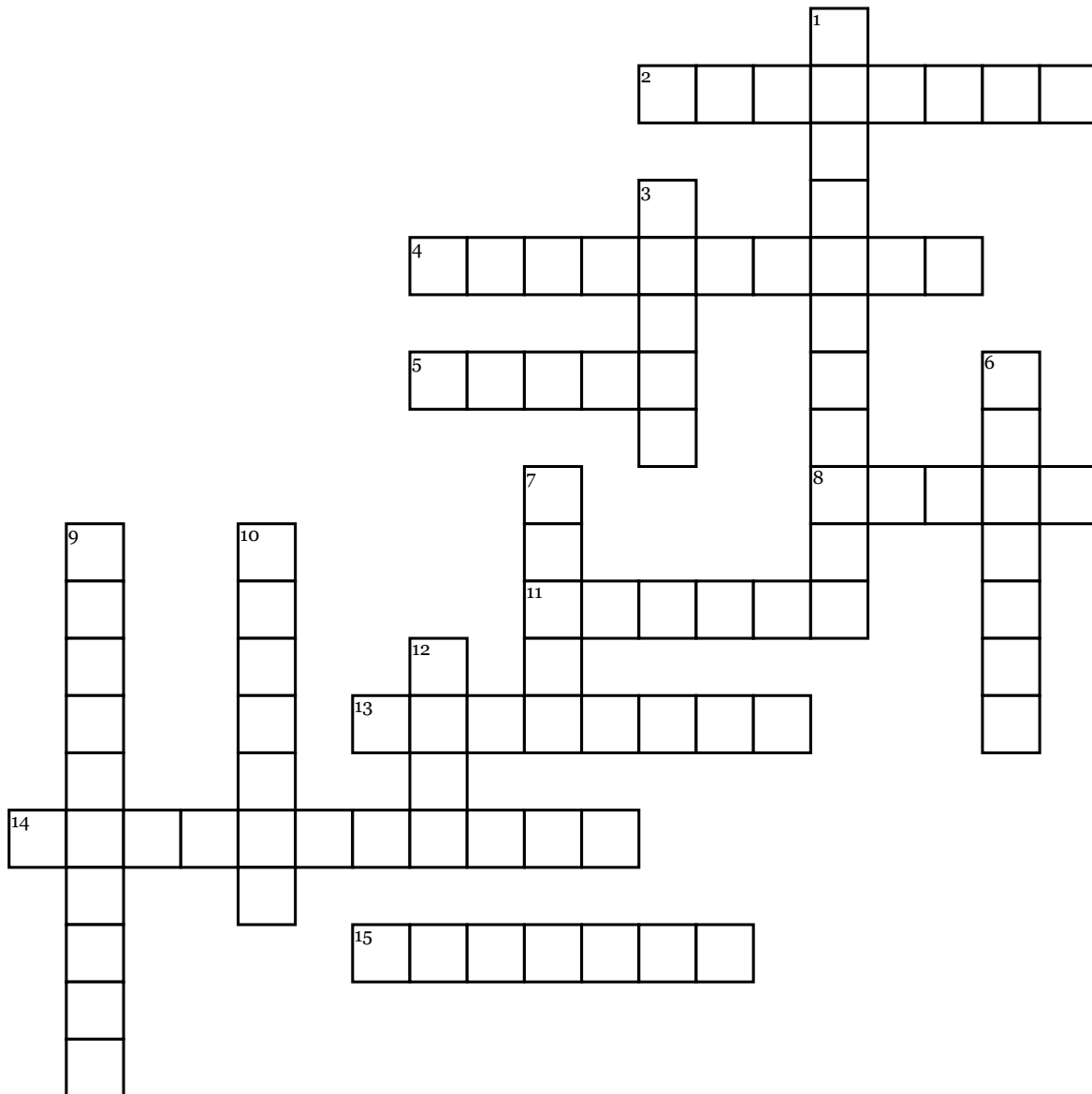


# Legal Responsibilities
