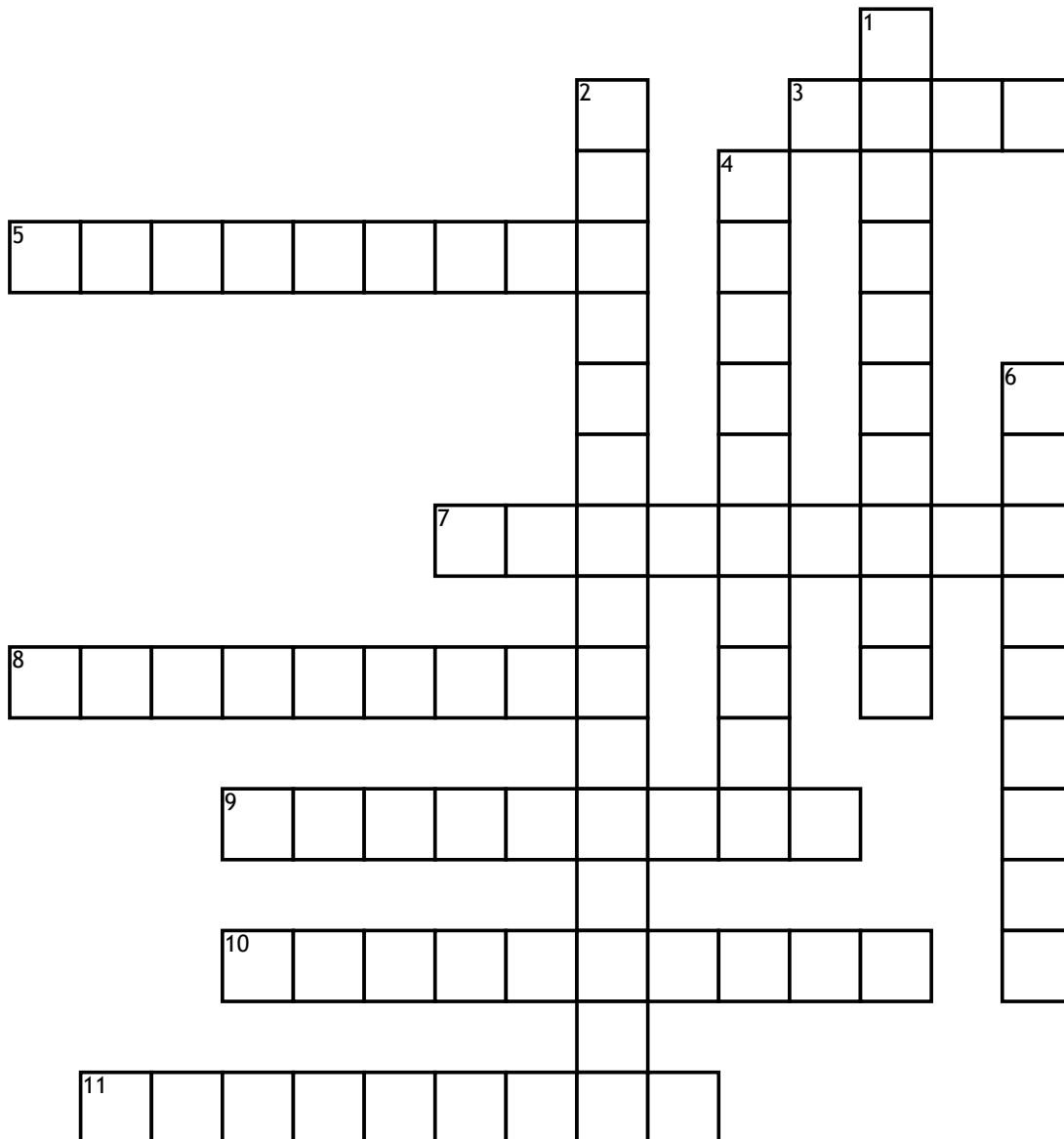


# Level 2 Sacramental

- 3. The consecrated body of christ
- 5. a relatively slight sin
- 7. the sacrament during Mass where bread and wine are consecrated and shared
- 8. a gravely sinful act, which leads to a separation of that person from God
- 9. a religious ceremony or ritual regarded as imparting divine grace, such as baptism, the Eucharist, penance and the anointing of the sick
- 10. an ornamented receptacle or cabinet in which a pyx or ciborium containing the reserved sacrament may be placed in Catholic churches, usually on or above an altar.

- 11. the Christian ceremony commemorating the Last Supper, in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed.

- 1. a formal admission of one's sins with repentance and desire of absolution, especially privately to a priest as a religious duty
- 2. the divine rules of conduct given by God to Moses on Mount Sinai
- 4. formal release from guilt, obligation, or punishment.
- 6. to lower one's body briefly by bending one knee to the ground and performing the sign of the Cross, typically in worship or as a sign of respect
