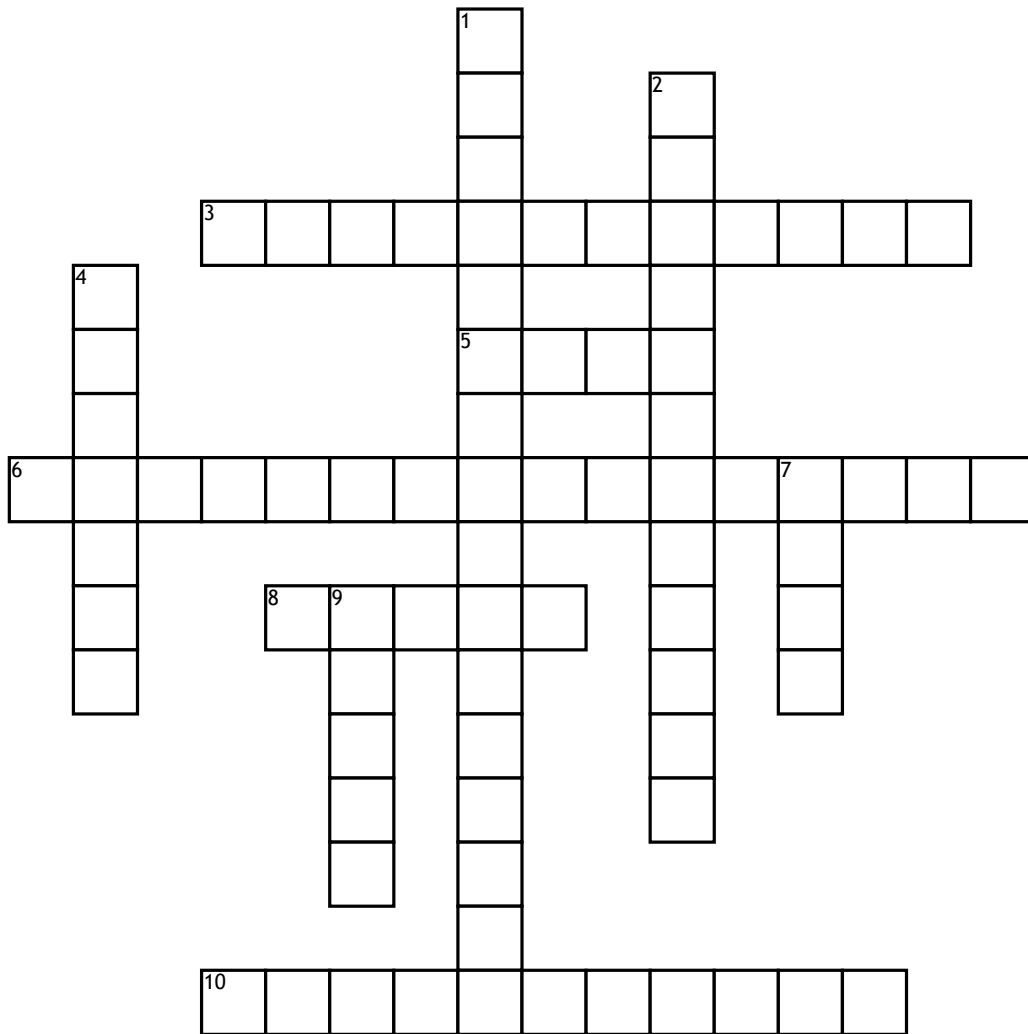


Levels of Organization
