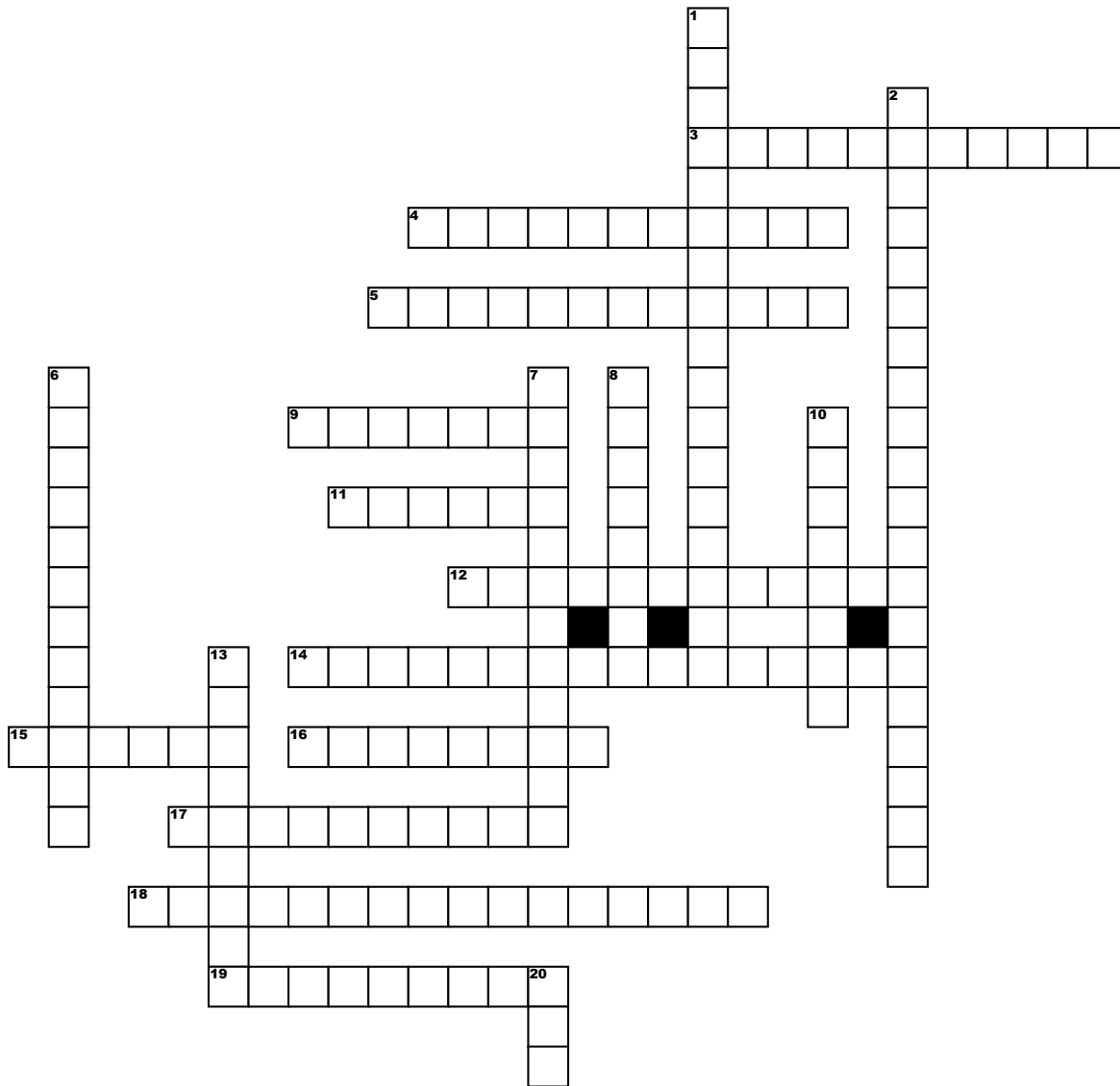


# Levels of organisation
