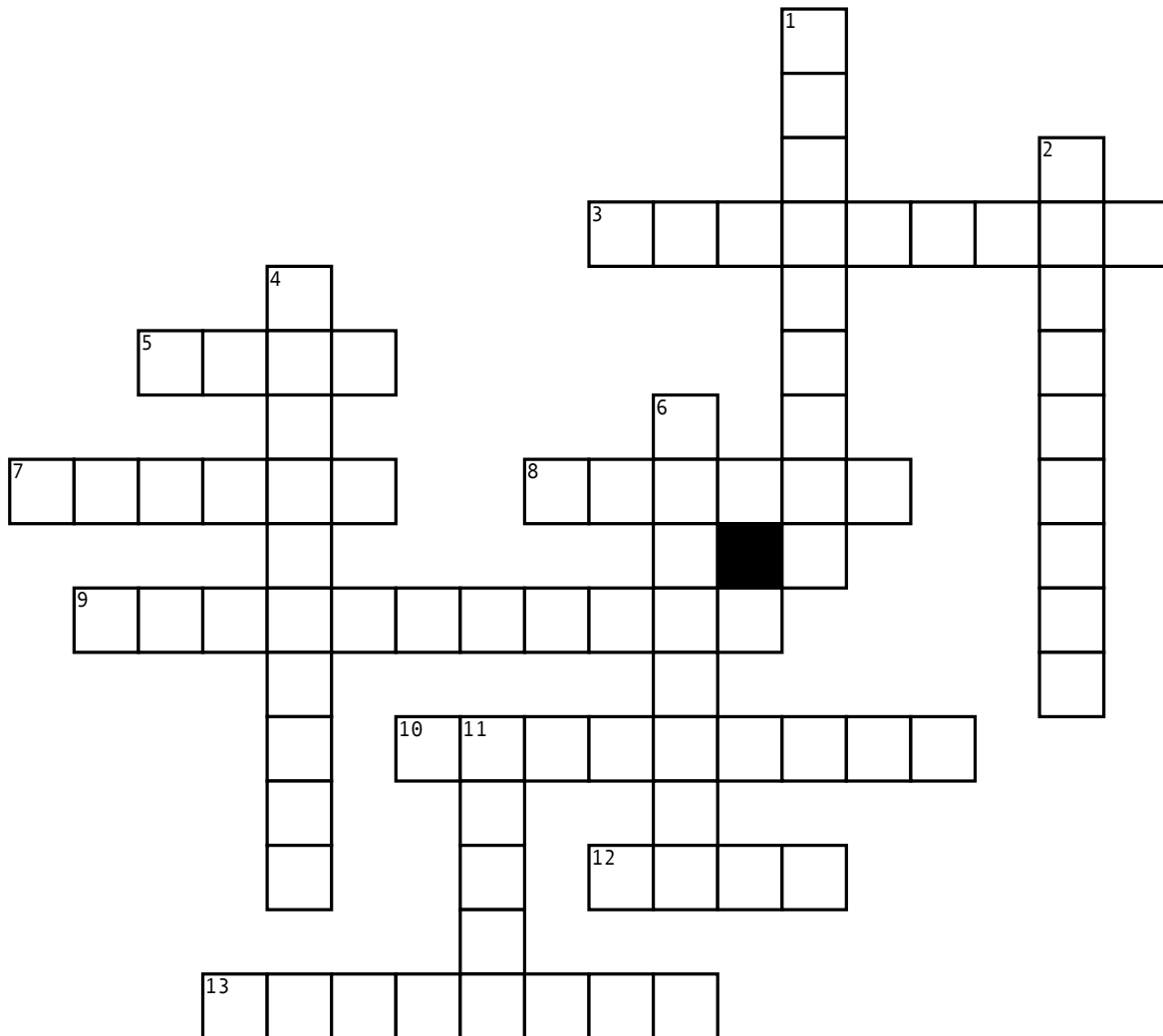


Levels of organization

- 3. The regions of the surface, atmosphere, and hydrosphere of the earth (or analogous parts of other planets) occupied by living organisms.
- 5. The basic unit of a chemical element
- 7. Material in which animals and plants are made of consisting cells and products

- 8. a large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat, e.g., forest or tundra.
- 9. A group of organisms that work together to perform one or more functions
- 10. A group of people living in the same place
- 12. The smallest structural and functional unit of an organism
- 13. An individual plant animal or single cell life form

- 1. A biological community of interacting organisms and their physical environment
- 2. Any of a number of organized or specialized structures within a living cell.
- 4. All the inhabitants of a particular town, area, or country.
