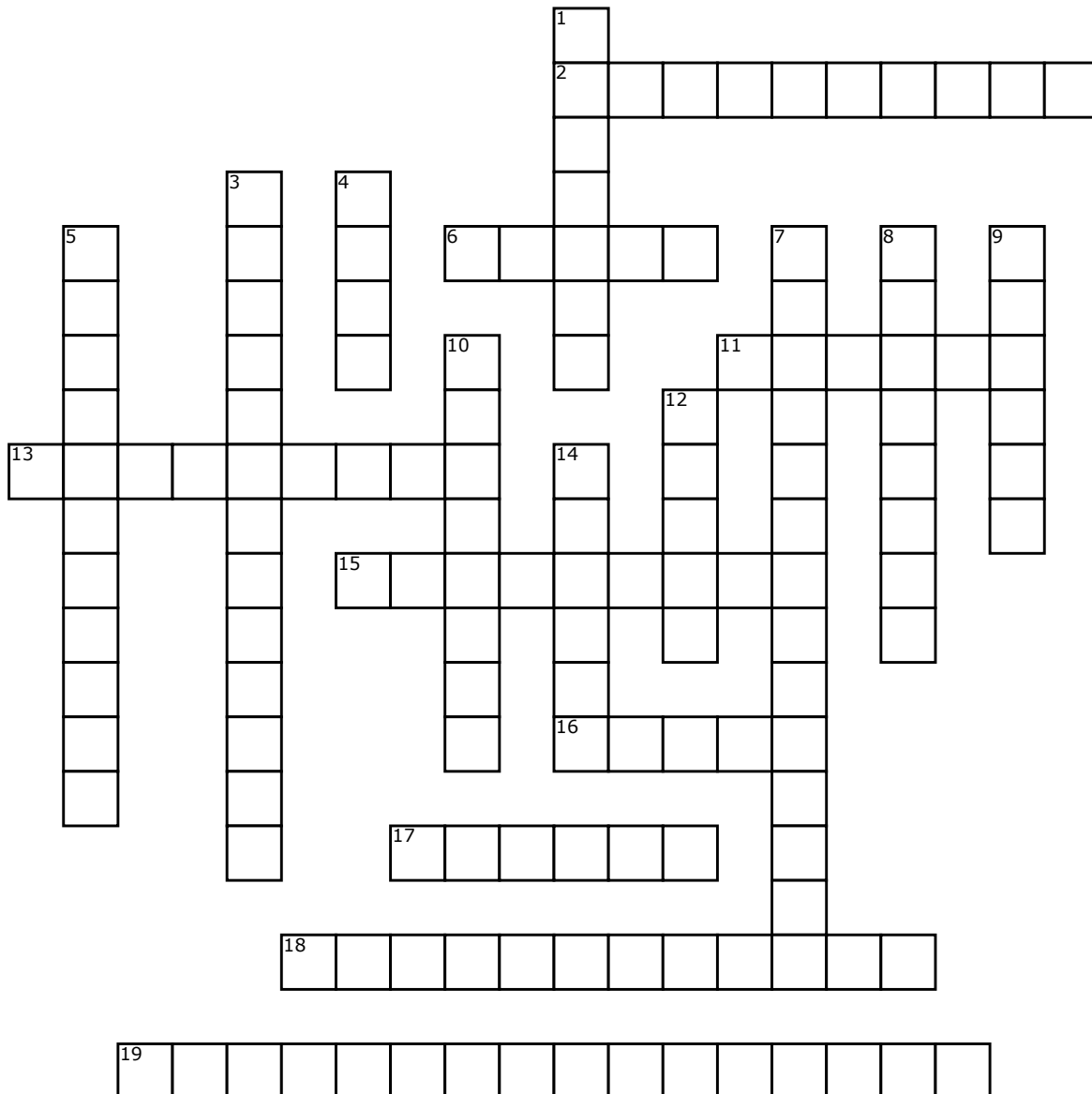


Leviticus - Deuteronomy

- 2.** This type of bread did not have yeast in it, what is this also known as?
6. Deuteronomy 6: 5-6 is also known as this. It is a very important prayer for the Jewish people.
