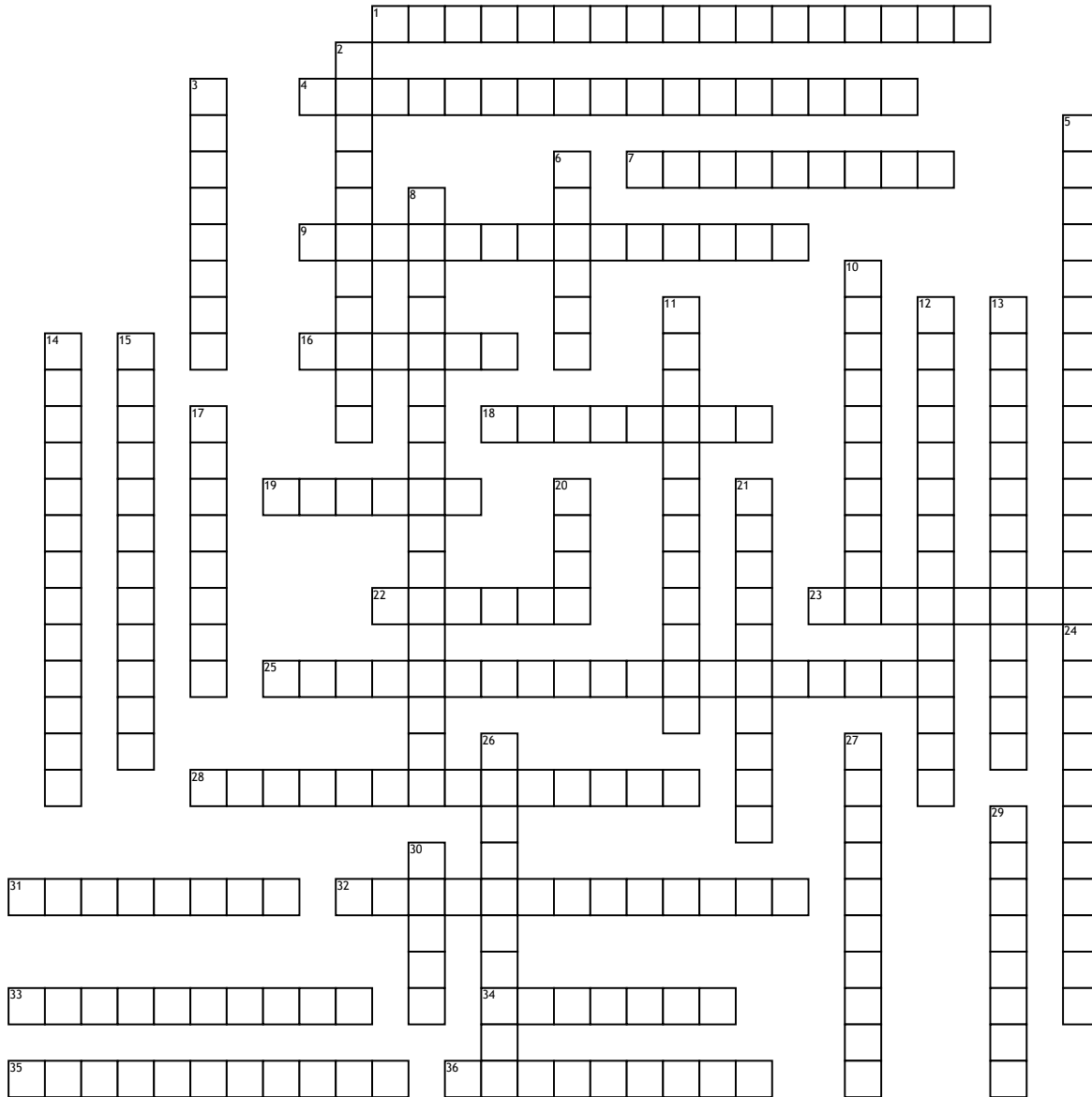


Library Crossword
