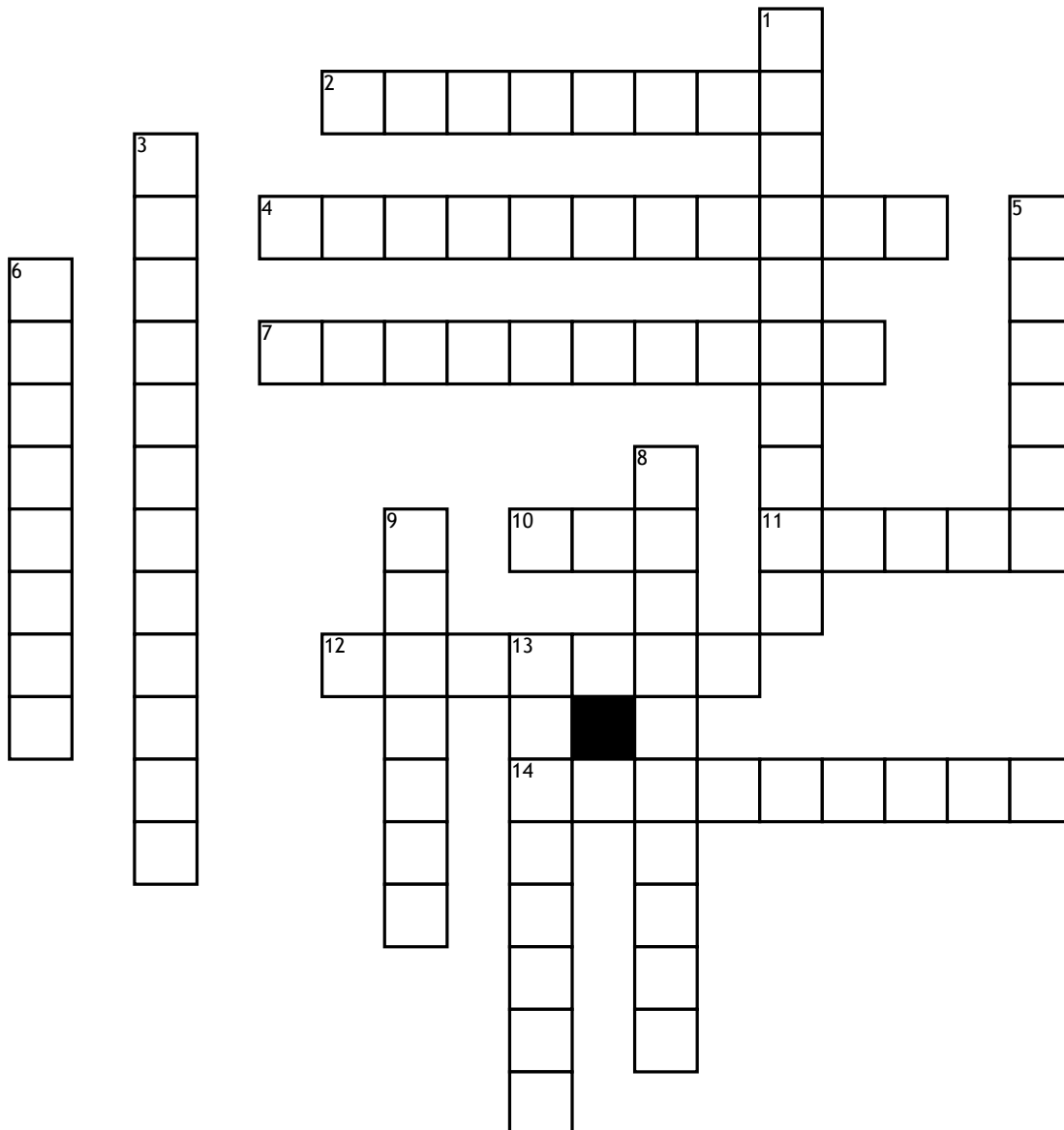


Literary Device
