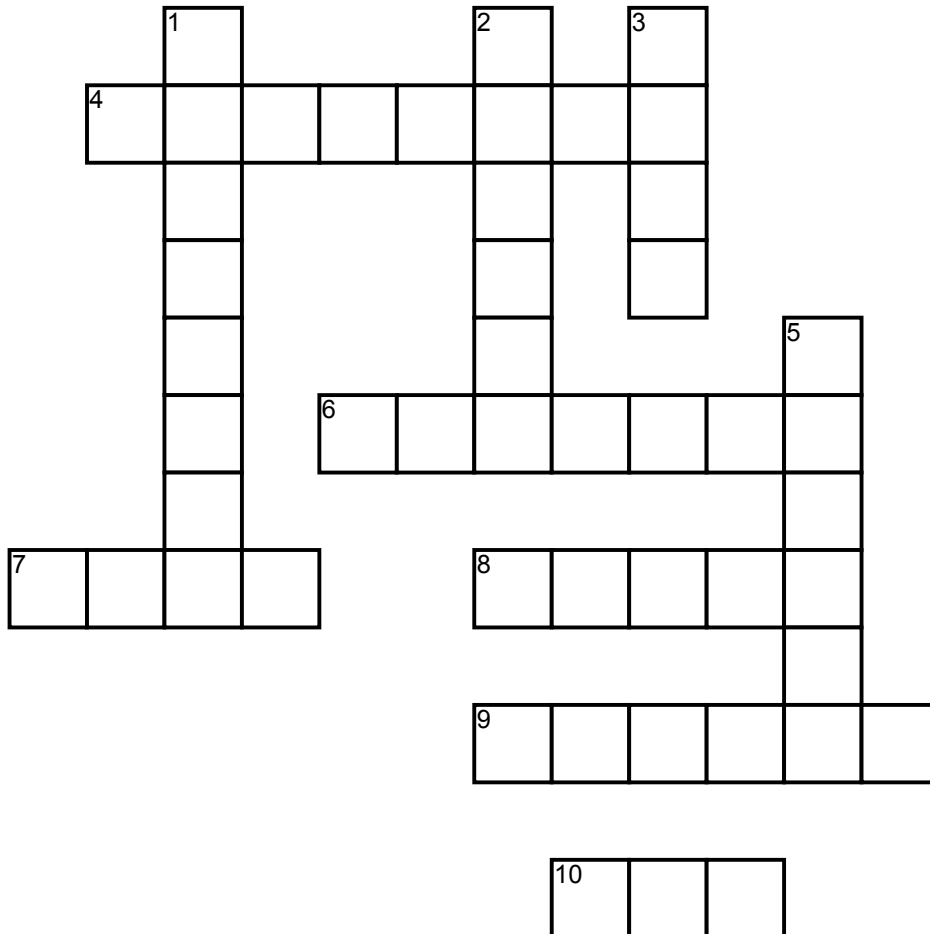


Literary Forms In The Bible
