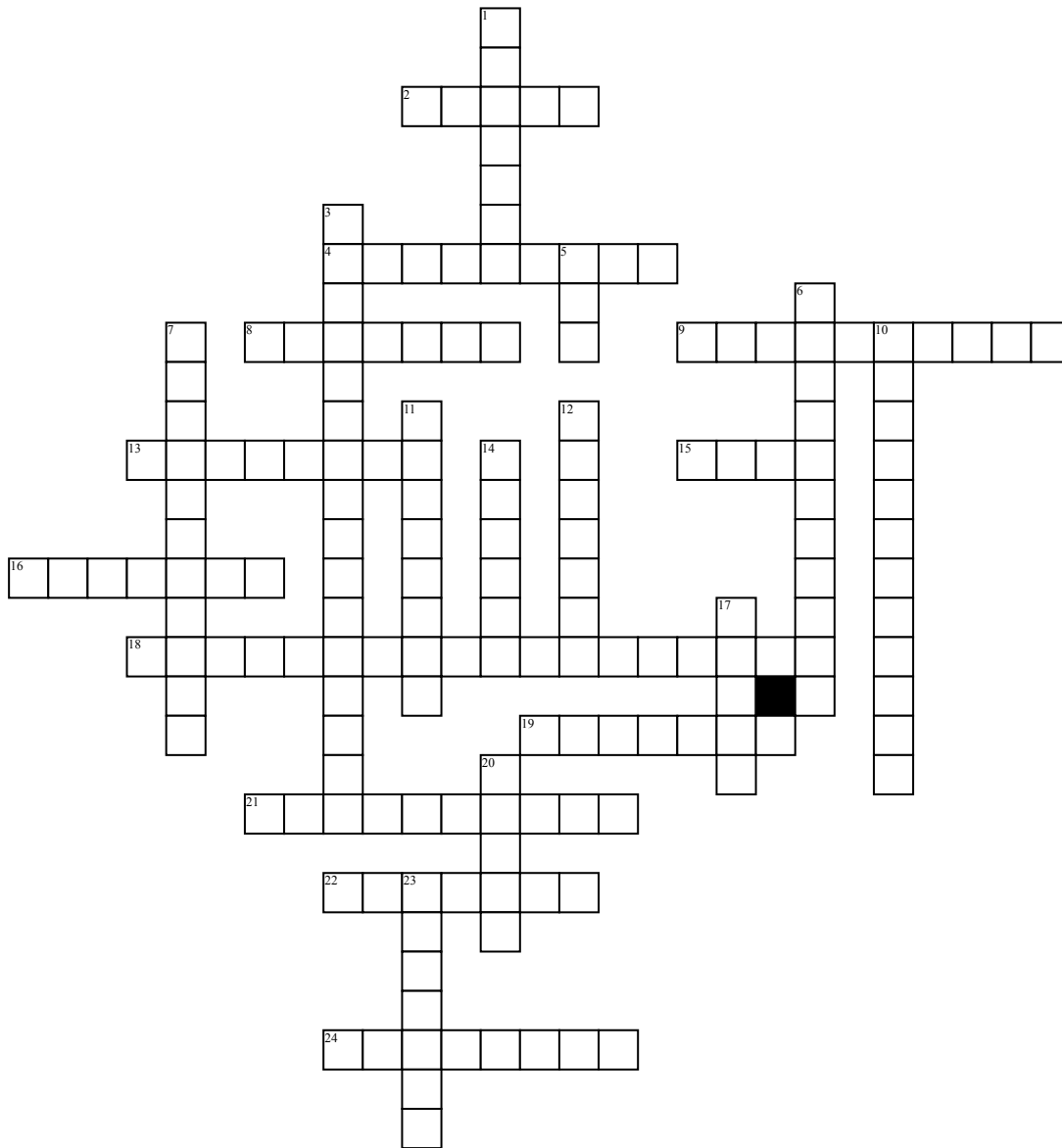

14. A simile is a figure of speech that makes a comparison, showing similarities between two different things and draws resemblance with the help of the words "like" or "as which demonstrate a direct comparison
17. a literary device that can be defined as a concise and brief story intended to provide a moral lesson at the end.
20. Is Any recurring element that has symbolic significance in a story. Through its repetition, a motif can help produce other narrative (or literary) aspects such as theme or mood.
