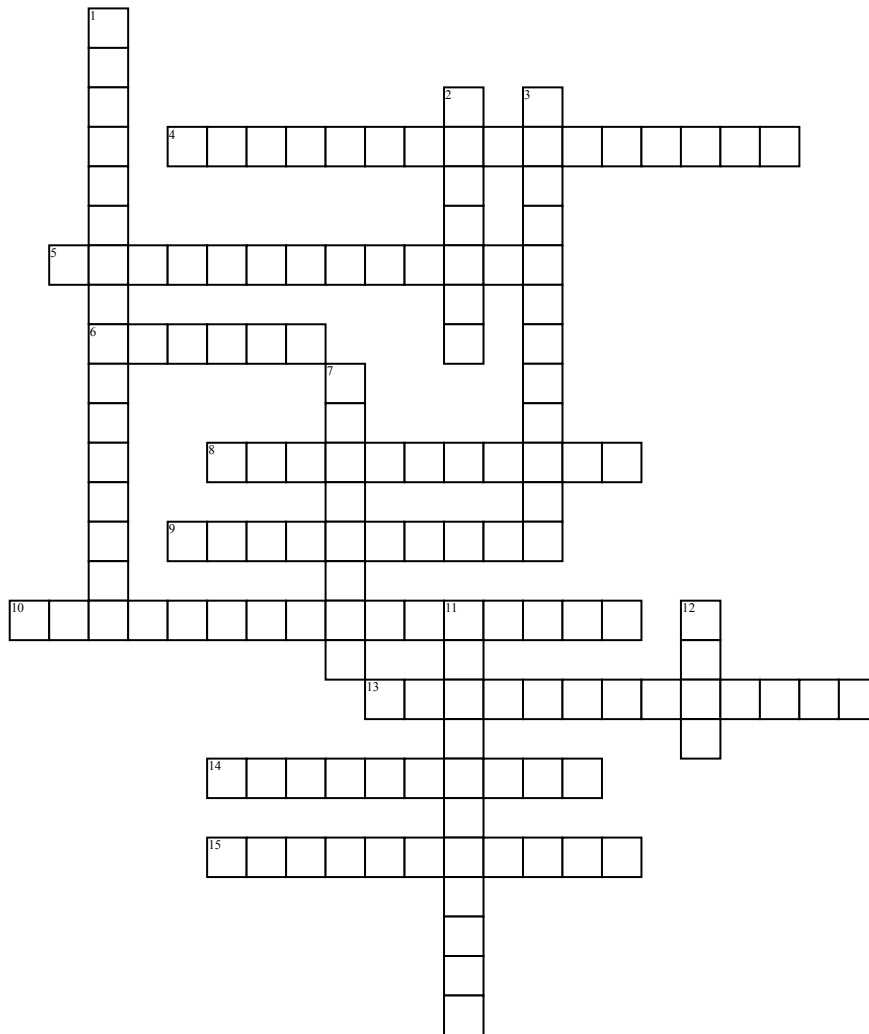

- 4. creation of characters using any of 6 methods
- 5. part of PLOT, events following the climax where the tension releases and the story begins to close
- 6. part of PLOT, the most intense part of a story where the conflict has reached its peak
- 8. perspective from which a story is told
- 9. part of PLOT, ending of a story where loose ends are tied up

- 10. clash of outside forces
- 13. hints provided by the author to suggest future events; creates suspense
- 14. part of the PLOT, beginning of the story where character and setting are revealed
- 15. story is told by someone outside the action (he, she)

- 3. part of PLOT, series of events leading up to the climax, driven by conflict
- 7. main problems or struggles in a story, drives the rising action
- 11. story is told by a character within the action (I, me, my)
- 12. all the events which make up the story
