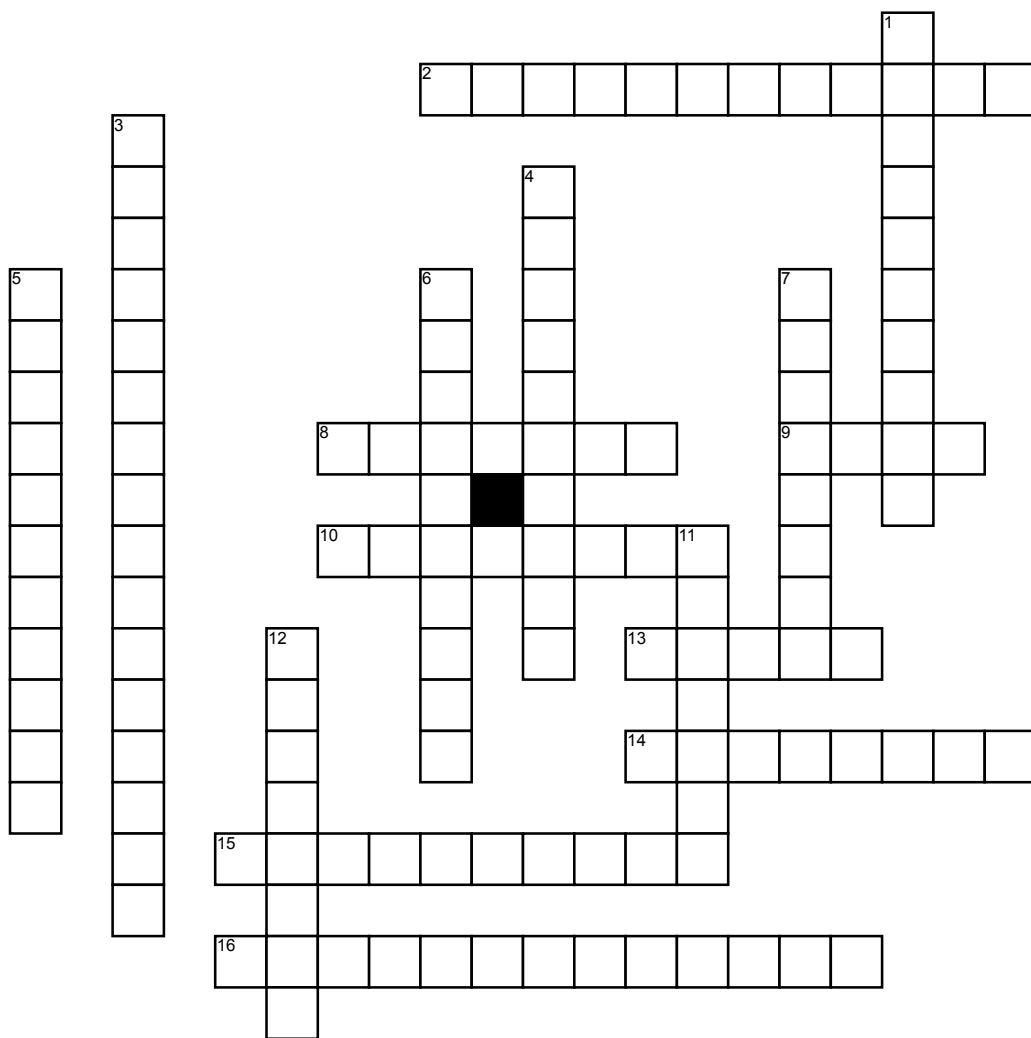


Liturgy

- 2.** Contains the opening prayer, prayer over the gifts, prayer after Holy Communion, and solemn blessings
- 8.** a long black garment worn by altar servers
- 9.** the stiff square, white cover that is placed over the Paten when it is on the Chalice
- 10.** a loose fitting robe with open sides and wide sleeves worn by a deacon
- 13.** the saucer-like disk used at mass to hold the bread which becomes the Body of Christ

- 14.** a vessel used to hold the Hosts

- 15.** a sacred vessel designed to expose the consecrated Host to the congregation

- 16.** an oil lamp or wax candle that burns near the tabernacle.

- 1.** The shrine that serves as a place for the exclusive reservation of the Blessed Sacrament

- 3.** Contains only the Gospel readings

- 4.** Contains the scripture readings for Mass

- 5.** a white cloth used to cleanse the Chalice

- 6.** Contains all the parts of the Mass

- 7.** this is a wide-sleeved garment, it is worn over the cassock

- 11.** The large cup used at Mass to hold the wine which becomes the Blood of Christ

- 12.** a white linen cloth on which are placed the vessels containing the bread and wine during Mass
