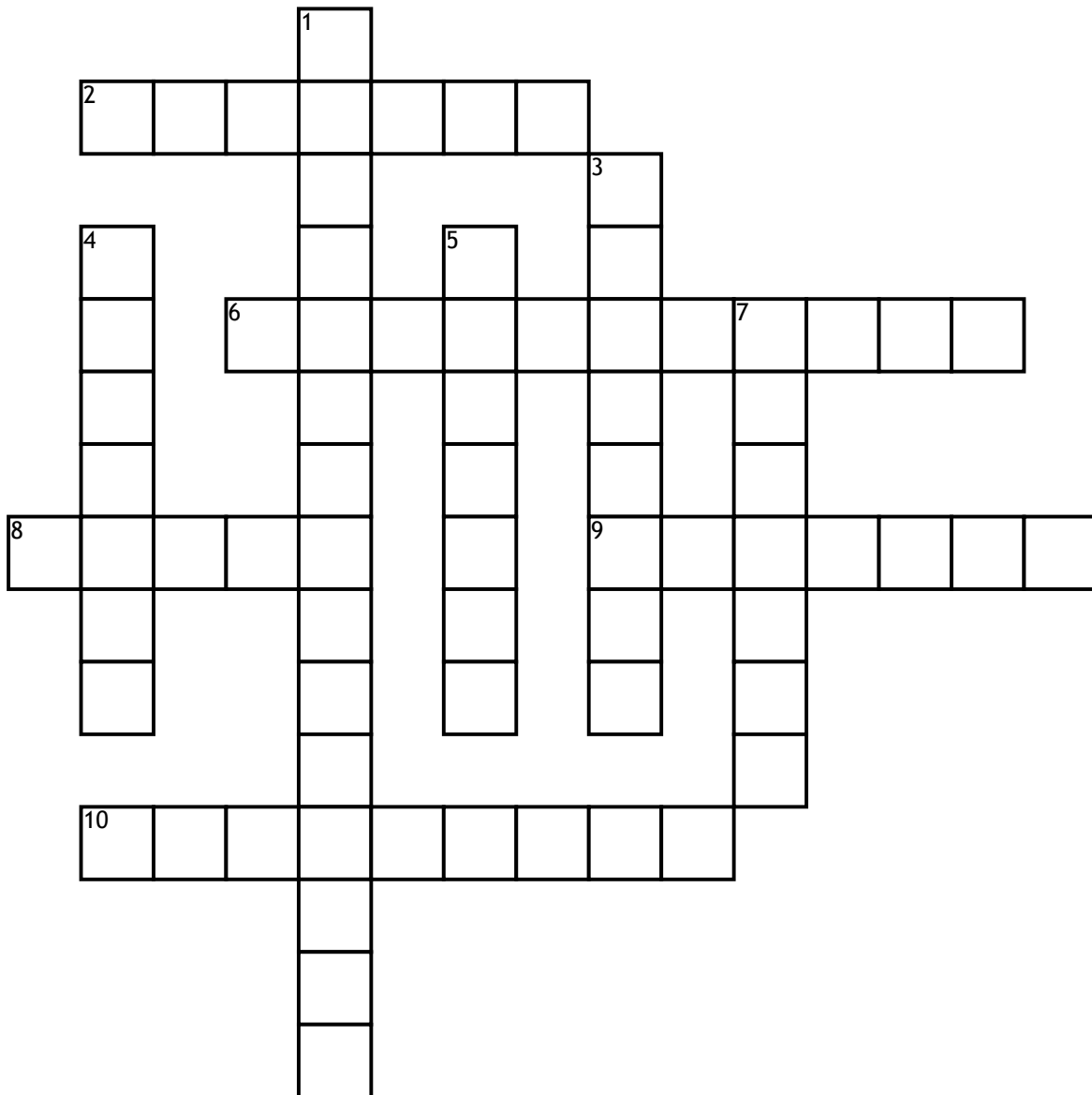


Location of Major bones

2. Connects with the clavicle and scapula to make the shoulder joint
6. The middle layer of bones, found in your feet
8. The thicker of the two bones found in your lower leg
9. The first layer of bones in your hand, found at the wrist joint
10. The last layer of bones, found in your hands and your feet

Down

1. Protects your spinal cord
3. The correct name for your 'collar bone'
4. The correct term for your 'skull'
5. This bone helps the knee joint to function efficiently
7. A flat bone that the ribs connect to
