# Lower Extremity Ulcers

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| 1. Location between toes, over phalangeal heads, and lateral malleolus                         | A. Arterial Wound  |
| 2. Even wound margins oval or round  | B. Arterial Ulcer  |
| 3. Location medial lower leg/ankle seldom if ever on the foot/above the knee                   | C. Venous Ulcer    |
| 4. Irregular wound margins   | D. Venous Ulcer    |
| 5. Location Plantar foot over metatarsal, and under heel                                       | E. Diabetic Ulcer  |
| 6. Even wound margins  | F. Venous Ulcer    |
| 7. Surrounding Tissue, Blanched, purpuric, thin, shiny, dry, hairless                          | G. Diabetic Ulcer  |
| 8. Surrounding Tissue Scalling, pruritic, weepy, brown dermatitis, firm edema                  | H. Venous Ulcer    |
| 9. Surrounding Tissue hyperkeratotic, callus, cellulitis                                       | I. Diabetic Ulcer  |
| 10. Sever pain, minimal drainage decreased temp., cyanosis, thick toenails, diminished pulses  | J. Arterial Ulcer  |
| 11. foot deformity, diminished sensation in the foot, palpable pulses, painless, osteomyelitis | K. Arterial Ulcers |
| 12. pain varies, ankle flare, dilated superficial veins, hard fibrosis surrounding tissue      | L. Diabetic Ulcer  |
